ERC STARTING GRANT

Day 1 (31 May 2012)

ERC STARTING GRANT

ERC ADVANCED GRANT

- Individualized support (no training sessions)
- Face-to-face meetings (Fall 2011)
- Feedback on your proposal (December – January)
- Support letter from University of Twente
- Deadline February – March 2012

MARIE CURIE GRANTS

- Great diversity in grants, applicants, location
- Single training event not very useful
- Can be very useful for mobility in your career
 - Post-doc
 - Starting a new position
 - Sabbatical

MARIE CURIE GRANTS

- Individual support available
- Also if you apply with another institution
- Special attention when you are hiring new staff
 - Take application deadlines in account
