ORE = opening of registration period for examinations, CRE = closing of registration period for examinations. Registration for written examinations is obligatory.

Spring holiday in the regions Middle & South of the Netherlands will be in week 2012-08 (February 20-24, 2012), TUD and TU/e will probably pick this week as their spring holiday week.

The most important Islamic religious periods and holidays are:

- Feast of the Sacrifice: Sunday, November 6th, 2011 (week 44) - Tuesday, November 8th, 2011 (week 45)
- Ramadan: Friday, July 20th, 2012 (week 29) - Saturday, August 18th, 2012 (week 33)
- Sugar Festival: Sunday, August 19th, 2012 (week 33) - Tuesday, August 21st, 2012 (week 34)

It is up to the faculties if and how the time-tables take these Islamic religious periods and holidays into consideration.¹

¹ Advice: the Feast of the Sacrifice is during an examination week for the major part. Please take this into consideration wherever possible. Ramadan and the Sugar Festival are during summer holiday. If possible, please do not schedule re-examinations during the Sugar Festival.
