MSc BA Programme Objectives

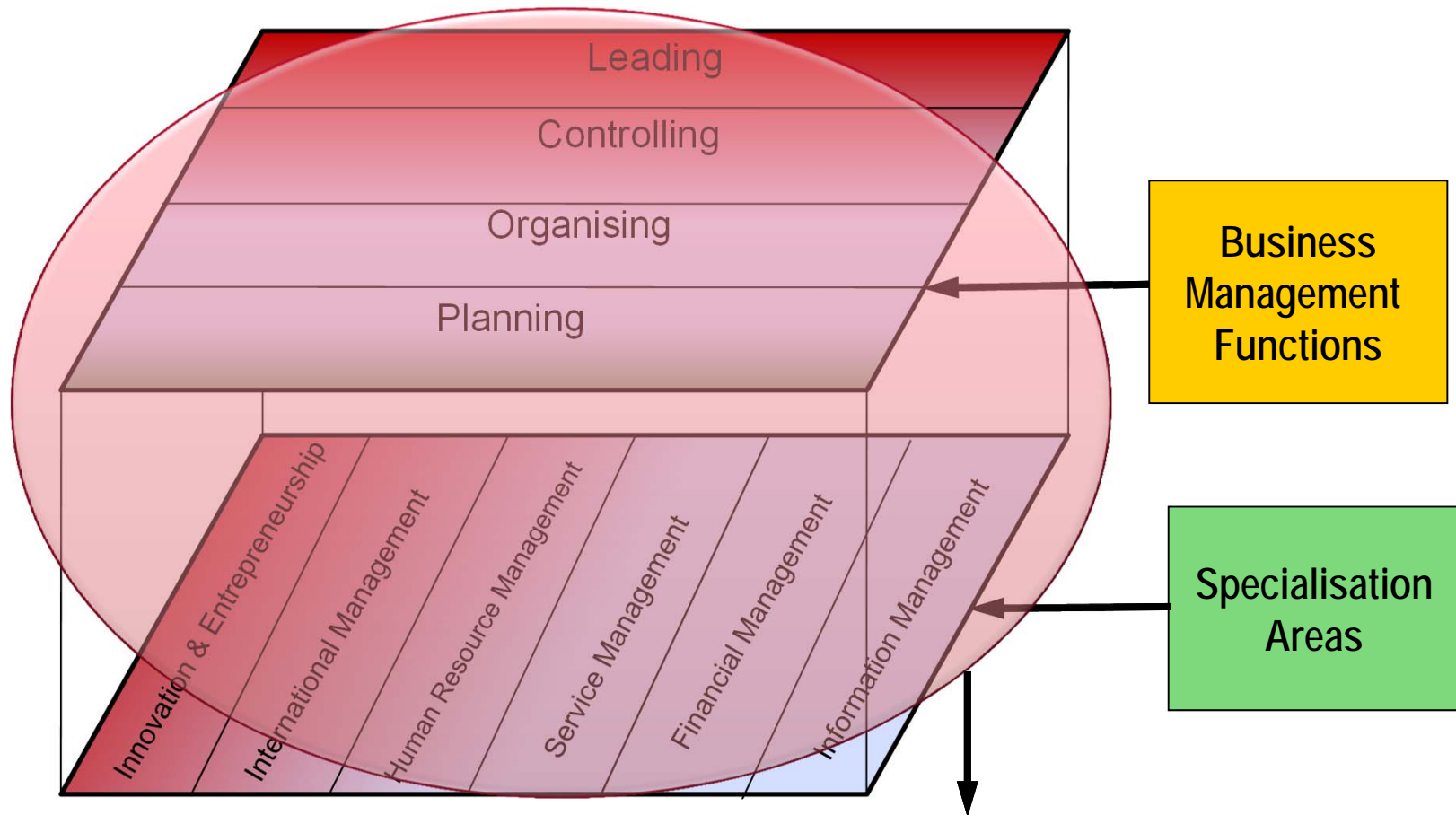
- Our main objectives are to:

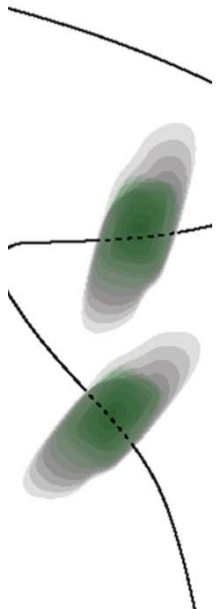

How can you get the best from your study?



■ Adequately prepare yourself

- A typical **5 EC course** represents about **140 hours** of study; an academic year (60 ECs) requires about 1680 hours (**42 weeks**) of full-time study.
- Do study regularly in each week. Be prepared to put some work in.
- Attend lectures / tutorials: you learn stuffs that you don't find in books.
- Think ahead of readings, assignments.
