Biography

Jonathan Linton is a Full Professor and Power Corporation Professor in the Management of Technological Enterprises at the Telfer School of Management, University of Ottawa, Canada. The primary focus of his research is and has been on breaches to traditional assumptions in operations that occur while dealing with emerging technologies and innovation. Prior to entering academe Dr. Linton has a number of years of work experience in the electronics industry managing and introducing new environmental and robotic technology to high volume manufacturing environments. His educational training includes a BEng (materials engineering), BSc (Biology), MBA and PhD (operations management). His work experience with technology integration in high volume high tech manufacturing environments, and consulting to firms on operational issues relating to emerging technologies is in line with many of the interests of both Canadian industry and government, in particular in the Ottawa region.



Professor Linton is also the director of the new Emerging Technologies and Innovation Management Laboratory, where researchers will use cutting-edge modeling and statistical software in a collaborative multidisciplinary environment to deal with the complex problem of determining how innovations can be used most effectively.

Dr. Linton is currently the Editor-in-Chief of Technovation: The International Journal of Technological Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Technology Management. This Elsevier journal is listed on the science citation index and is a premier outlet for work on innovation and technology management. Dr. Linton has served as editorial board member and/or guest editor on a number of prestigious academic journals including: Engineering Management Journal, IEEE Transactions on Engineering Management, Journal of Operations Management, and Technological Forecasting and Social Change. Dr. Linton has published over 40 peer-reviewed articles in a range of management and engineering journals. He has also written various book chapters, trade magazine articles and papers in conference proceedings.
