3. Continuing Professional Development in Teaching (CPD-T) for BMS lecturers with UTQ

(and having > 160 hours of yearly teaching tasks)

You as BMS lectures with UTQ (or exempted for this) are offered facilities and opportunities for continuing professional development in teaching (CPD-T).

As lecturers, you have an important role in providing students with an optimal learning environment. Educational development and innovation are important in this. Moreover we expect this development and innovation is an interesting and motivating part of your educational tasks. To facilitate and support you in

these tasks you are offered a variety of opportunities for **keeping up-to-date on current trends** and technologies and to **develop new and advanced skills and knowledge**.

We suggest you to collaborate, in your CPD-T, with colleagues. Sharing experience and joint learning can be very inspiring and effective. Discuss your ideas in your section/department and set up a multi-year plan together. Use the coming academic year 2021-2022 for orientation and starting as well as setting-up plans.

The BMS Teaching Academy likes to facilitate you and support the organization of CPD-T activities. Inform us about the facilities and support of important to you. We will start with a Professional Learning Community (PLC) on Blended Learning. PLCs are new opportunities for CPD-T activities. Maybe you want to join or start a PLC too? Let us know!

The offer: Yearly 24 hours on CPD-T activities can be included in your teaching task OR costs (< € 1680) can be covered. For these arrangements alignment with your section is necessary. The BMS departments and sections are asked to integrate the CPD-T plans of their staff and to take care of the relation with the educational tasks and costs.
