- **3.** Continuing Professional Development in Teaching (CPD-T) for BMS lecturers with UTQ (and having > 160 hours of yearly teaching tasks)

You as BMS lectures with UTQ (or exempted for this) are offered facilities and opportunities for continuing professional development in teaching (CPD-T).

To facilitate and support you in these tasks you are offered a variety of opportunities for **keeping up-to-date on current trends** and technologies and to **develop new and advanced skills and knowledge**.

We suggest you to collaborate, in your CPD-T, with colleagues. Sharing experience and joint learning can be very inspiring and effective. Discuss your ideas in your section/department and set up a multi-year plan together. Use the coming academic year 2021-2022 for orientation and starting as well as setting-up plans.
