

Information on registering for the master's programme in Applied Mathematics before finishing bachelor/premaster

Because of the COVID-19 crisis the Dutch government has proposed softer regulations for the bachelor's-before-master's rule. On the basis of this, the UT board has established further regulations for the smooth transfer to master's programmes, including the following:

1. This 'COVID-19 temporary smooth transfer' is only possible per 1 September 2020!
2. This measure only applies to funded master's programmes, therefore students who wish to apply for a non-funded master's programme must hold a bachelor's degree.
3. This measure does not apply to non-EEA students. These students have to be in possession of a bachelor's degree.

In addition, to be able to use the 'COVID-19 temporary smooth transfer' to the MSc programme in Applied Mathematics the following conditions must be satisfied.

1. The bachelor student should have, on 31-08-2020, no more than 30 EC open from his/her bachelor's programme.
The premaster students should have no more than 6 EC open in the pre-master's programme.
2. The bachelor's programme must be completed before 1-9-2021, and if applicable, the premaster's programme must be completed before 1-3-2021.
3. The student must obtain the conditional admission to the MSc-AM programme, as per the procedure mentioned below.
4. The enrolment to the MSc-AM programme must be completed before 01-09-2020. After that the temporary smooth transfer will not be available anymore and the original BSc/MSc separation will be in effect again.

For the current UT-bachelor or pre-master students, the required documents and the procedure for conditional admission and enrolment are as follows.

Required documents

For conditional admission, you must provide the following documents:

1. The signed application form "MSc Applied Mathematics before BSc graduation".
On this form you should give the following information:
 - Your current bachelor's programme.
 - The courses in your bachelor's programme that you did not complete yet.
 - The desired specialisation of the master's programme.
 - The master courses that you want to follow before graduating from your bachelor's programme.
2. A study plan, containing a time schedule of the remaining bachelor courses, the new master courses and the planned date of the bachelor's graduation, approved by the coordinator of your bachelor's programme.
In the study plan, priority must be given to graduation from the bachelor's programme as soon as possible. Unnecessary delay of the completion of bachelor's units will not be accepted.
3. A detailed overview of the study results in the bachelor's programme.

Assessment of the applications

Applications will be checked on the following conditions:

- The study plan leads to the bachelor's graduation as soon as possible, and it indeed prevents study delay.
- Sufficient prior knowledge is available to follow the chosen master courses.
- Chosen master courses fit the chosen specialisation.

Application procedure for conditional admission to MSc-AM

1. Discuss your study plan with the bachelor coordinator of your study programme and if necessary, with the study-adviser.
2. Fill in and sign the application form yourself (possibly digitally).
3. Let the application form and your study plan be signed (possibly digitally) by the bachelor-coordinator of your study programme.
4. Send the application form and the study plan, both signed by you and the bachelor coordinator, along with the detailed overview of your study results in the bachelor to the master-coordinator of Applied Mathematics (j.schut@utwente.nl).
5. If approved, the master coordinator will send an email to the Bureau of Educational Affairs (BOZ) and to [SAS/Registration](#) with your details (name and student number) to signal the conditional admission.
In addition, you and BOZ will receive a copy of the signed application form.
6. Also, make sure that per 1 September 2020, you are
 - re-enrolled for the current bachelor's or pre-master's programme; and
 - enrolled for the MSc-AM programme via Studielink.

Important deadlines

The following deadlines must be met to enrol in the MSc-AM programme using the 'COVID-19 temporary smooth transfer' regulation:

- 24-August-2020: submission of application to j.schut@utwente.nl
- 31-August-2020: (re)enrolling for your current programme as well as MSc-AM programme
