Status update: Data cleaning

While we did encounter a couple of issue when we first started testing the cleaning functionality in the test environment, these have been fixed now and we have been able to successfully clean data within the test environment of Mobility-Online.

The next step is to identify which data has to be clean in which time frame within the production environment. The project team regarding data cleaning will reach out to the faculties and other services involved to discuss the legal retainment periods as well as the implications of deleting the data permanently from Mobility-Online.



Visit UCLL: any important points to share?

In the last week of November our Mobility-Online team and a member of SOIR visited our Belgian colleagues at University Colleges Leuven Limburg. There we met up with colleagues from Windesheim (Zwolle) as well. During this visit we shared our knowledge (and complaints) regarding EWP, exchanged best practices regarding general troubleshooting, learned form each other's process implementations and discussed how to 'join forces' with respect to our shared wish list for developments in Mobility-Online. For example, we learned about a way to delay the question regarding changes in the 'During the mobility' phase. This is one we will try to implement quickly, as it prevents students to mark the question as "No" before they have even started their program and thus do not really know whether or not they actually do need to make changes.



Status update: New user interface & Mobility-Online Website

Introduction is delayed as we are having trouble testing the complete student route. LISA is currently looking into this, but unfortunately we cannot say when the issue regarding test students for Mobility-Online is resolved. We will keep you informed.

Furthermore, we are currently working on making our Mobility-Online website more user friendly. Together with our colleague from marketing and communications we are restructuring the website to group anything related to "students" in one section and all "staff" related information in another section. We expect to have these changes implemented early 2024.
