Master's programme Psychology 2018-2019

The Master's programme in Psychology (60EC, 1 year) offers five (specialization) tracks in the field of psychology:

- Human Factors & Engineering Psychology (in English)
- Conflict, Risk & Safety (in English)
- Learning Sciences (in English)
- Health Psychology & Technology (in English)
- Positieve Psychologie & Technologie (in Dutch, in English as of september 2019-2020)

Four of the tracks are taught in English, this means that:

- Study materials are in English.
- Classes (lectures, seminars, workshops, practicals, and others) are taught in English.
- Exams and assignments are composed in English and students have to complete all exams and assignments in English.
- Presentations (including the master thesis presentation) have to be prepared in English

Students can start the master(tracks) in September or February. The programme for student who enrol in February can be found in this document.

For students who failed to complete more than one of the courses it is important to contact the study adviser for consultation on how to complete the master's programme.

For students who did not sit for an exam for one or more of the courses it is necessary to contact the study adviser for consultation on how to complete the (appropriate) master's programme ((at least) 60EC). In general, students are bound to the following transitional arrangements: the units of study of the 2017-2018 programme are replaced by the current Psychology graduation units of study as listed in the table below.
