Additional paragraphs related to students in the MSc programme Membrane Engineering for Sustainable Development (MESD), starting September 2024.

**Article 11 Final examination**

Students who meet all of the following conditions have passed the master's final examination (WHW Art. 7.10 paragraph 2):

d) In case of students following the MESD-programme, the examination elements are those of the MESD programme done at the University of Twente.

**Article 12 Exceptional ability ("Cum Laude")**

h. If the student completed the final year of the MESD programme at the University of Twente, the paragraphs a-d) of this Article apply to the grades that are registered in the Student Information System for the programme elements related to this programme.

The student must have completed the MESD master programme part of this programme within a maximum of one year and three months (15 months).

Exemptions ((personal) circumstances) on this period can on request be considered by the Examination Board.

**Article 13 Master's final project committee**

In addition to paragraph 3 The master's final project committee consists of at least three members. The committee must meet the following conditions:

...

- In case of a MSc assignment within the MESD programme one member of the committee must be a member of the permanent academic staff of another research group of one of the other universities participating in the MESD programme.

**Mandate**

The Secretary of the CSE Examination Board is mandated to approve individual study programmes, the MSc assignment project proposal, the composition of the Master's final project committee for students following the MESD programme at the University of Twente.
