Background information

Arabesque is a contemporary dance group for students in Enschede. It was founded in 1992 by a number of enthusiastic students and has since grown into an active association. We celebrate dance and freedom of expression through it.

Classes are always on Tuesday evening between 18:00 and 21:00, there are two different time slots of 1.5 hours. The schedule will always be timely communicated with the members. Within Arabesque there are three groups based on dancers' levels and experience:

- Beginners, this is advised for those who do not have any dance experience.
- Intermediate, this is advised for those who have some dance experience.
- Advanced, this is advised for those who have multiple years of dance experience.

Signing up, membership and payment

There are 4 stages to be checked in this process. **Note:** The <u>association</u> fee is different from the <u>membership</u> fee. The association fee goes to the university and makes sure we have the teachers and the rooms available. The membership fee goes directly to Arabesque for activities, costumes, dance shows and keeping the association alive and kicking \odot .

- ✓ Stage 1: UnionCard / CampusCard
- ✓ Stage 2: Association fee
- ✓ Stage 3: Membership fee
- ✓ Stage 4: You are an Arabesque member!



✓ Stage 1: UnionCard / Campuscard

Online for UnionCard:

- 1. Go to https://sportsandculture.utwente.nl/pages/login and log in;
- 2. Go to the "Shop" and then "Subscriptions" and purchase the UnionCard for a half year or a full year;

In person for UnionCard:

The UnionCard can also be bought at the Service desk of The University of Twente's Sports Center. If you have any questions regarding the membership and singing up process, people at the Sports Center can be of assistance, too.

In person for CampusCard:

If you are not a student of the University of Twente, you will have to buy a CampusCard instead of a UnionCard. For the exact prices please visit: https://www.utwente.nl/en/campuscard/prices/. To buy a CampusCard, you need to visit the Service desk of the Sports Center UT. You also need to pay the association fee at the counter; otherwise, it will cost twice as much!

✓ <u>Stage 2: Association fee</u>

- 1. Go to https://sportsandculture.utwente.nl/pages/login and log in. (Or go to the Service desk of the Sports Center UT, advised for non-UT students.)
- 2. Go to "My Organizations". You will find a header with "Join" there. If you fill in *Arabesque* and click on "Save", you will send us a request to join.
- 3. We will accept you as soon as we have received this application form, make sure you email it to us: board.arabesque@gmail.com with the title: "Sign up form + your name".
- 4. When accepted, you can pay the association fee when you open the "Shop" (22 euros for a half a year and 35 euros for the full academic year of 2024/2025).

✓ <u>Stage 3: Membership fee</u>

When all above is taken care of, we will send you an email about our membership fee. You have to pay this to Arabesque, the email will include the bank number.

✓ <u>Stage 4: You are an Arabesque member!</u>

If you did all the steps correctly, you will receive an email stating that you are officially an Arabesque member!

Important: If you are a member, but you do not own a UnionCard (or a CampusCard) and/or did not pay the association fee, the Student Union will fine Arabesque and **you will have to pay this fine**.



What is expected of you

<u>Presence</u>: By signing this form, you are expected to be present at the lessons. Of course, due to various reasons, you might miss out a class. However, if you happen to be absent for a longer period of time, please send an email to the board to let us know.

<u>Equipment</u>: We dance barefoot or in socks, in comfortable clothes; no special dance outfit or equipment is required. It is advised to bring a water bottle with you.

<u>Attitude</u>: We treat each other with respect and make sure everyone feels accepted and welcome in our dance community. Your personal stuff can be placed in the classroom or in a locker. We leave the classroom tidy and clean.

<u>Social media</u>: All the videos and photos taken should be verbally consented to before being taken.
