About the Universiteits Council 2019 - 2020

In the upcoming budget year the university as a whole and its faculties receive large extra budgets: the result of increasing student numbers (about M€ 10, including tuition fees) and government decisions on the research sector plans (M€ 7 per year) and extra van Rijn budget for Technical/Bèta education (M€ 3.5 in 2020, M€ 8.5 as from 2022).
