 - Starts with a Kick-off workshop (February 2026)
 - Workshops, e.g. research management, meeting the editor, science slam; personal pursuit, personal effectiveness
 - **COMMUNICATION, INNOVATION AND SOCIETY (5 ECTS)**
 - February – April 2026
 - Science communication, science-society relationships
 - Includes Scientific Integrity module and using AI responsibly
 - **RESEARCH HONOURS TRAINING AND PROJECT (5 ECTS)**
 - Scientific Research Writing training (from end March 2026)
 - Individual coaching
 - Research article
