ADDENDUM TO ENROLMENT REGULATIONS 2023-2024: REFUGEE, TEMPORARY PROTECTION AND ASYLUM-SEEKING STUDENTS

- 1. This addendum supplements the Enrolment Regulations 2023-2024 as published on https://www.utwente.nl/en/education/student-services/enrolment/enrolment-regulations/
- 2. This addendum was approved by the Executive Board of the University of Twente on 11th of July 2022.
- 3. Wherever there is any conflict between this addendum and the Enrolment Regulations 2023-2024, the provisions of the Enrolment Regulations 2023-2024 are leading.
- 4. Notwithstanding any provisions under the Enrolment Regulations 2023-2024, the Executive Board of the University of Twente has decided that:
 - a. A student is entitled to an institutional tuition fee equal to the amount of the statutory fee if the students meet all of the criteria below:
 - *i.* The student is enrolled in a funded educational programme at a university or university of applied sciences in the Netherlands.
 - *ii.* At the start of the academic year, the student has not yet obtained a similar diploma for a funded educational programme. That means that the student does not have a Bachelor's degree when enrolling in a Bachelor's programme and does not have a Master's degree when enrolling in Master's programme.
 - iii. At the start of the academic year, the student is legally staying in the Netherlands either because the student a) requested asylum and is in possession of a so-called W-document or b) because the student is subjected to the 'Richtlijn Tijdelijke Bescherming' (European Council Directive 2001/55/EG of 20 July 2001) in The Netherlands.
 - b. The student who meets all criteria under a. is entitled to an institutional tuition fee equal to the amount of the statutory fee for a maximum of the nominal study duration for the programme in which the student is enrolled in the academic year 2023-2024.
 - c. When the nominal study duration is surpassed and there are no recognised personal circumstances as meant by WHW article 7.51 and detailed in the UT <u>FOBOS</u> regulation, the student will have to pay the regular institutional tuition fee rate.
 - d. When the student does not stay legally in the Netherlands (anymore), the student is not entitled (anymore) to an institutional tuition fee at the rate of the statutory tuition fee but instead pays the regular institutional tuition fee. The student does not stay legally in The Netherlands when a) the 'Richtlijn Tijdelijke Bescherming' is no longer in effect and the student has not requested or been granted asylum or b) if the request for asylum in The Netherlands has been rejected.
