1. Opening and Announcments

- a. The meeting is opened at 09:04 by Klein Brinke
- b. Present Members: Klein Brinke, Burema, Zalewska, Schaafstal, Blom, Houwelingen Snippe, Dertien, Buser (online), van Ierssel (online)
- c. Van Delden, Englebienne, Moneta, Klaassen, Snel are not present
- d. Klein Brinke announces he has to leave at 9:55
- e. Burema informs that the students did not receive the agenda through email
- Schaafstal announces that Creative technology at the VU has been awarded a TOP Program by the Keuzegids
- g. Roland van Rijswijk is the new teacher for Internet Technology at UT. Klein Brinke will potentially become the Internet Technology teacher for the VU.
 - Schaafstal highlights that van Rijswijk wants to make the course fit CreaTe better
- h. There is still an opening for Data Driven Analysis (DDA) for both CreaTe and the VU
- i. Snel is trying to solve the issue of getting teaching capacity from the VU side. She is trying to solve it by also including people from the steering group (from the UT-VU collaboration) to share the struggles they experienced.
 - Schaafstal highlights the importance of finding the teacher in time
- j. Vincent Groenhuis will take over from D. Dresscher in Introduction to Physical Systems (IPS).
 - i. Dertien highlights that he would be a good fit for CreaTe despite a hearing impairment and is very pleasant to work with.

- ii. Zalewska indicates that he will use some online lectures for his course.
- k. There is a new teacher for Ethics of AI at both the UT and the VU
- I. Schaafstal communicates that there has been a change regarding the BSA.
 - i. The rule used to be that if you stopped before the 1st of February you would not receive any BSA so you could start over the next year without any issues. Sometimes some grades would come out after the 1st of February which affects people's decisions. Therefore, a new change has been made which means that:
 - Stop before 1 Feb → No BSA → You can start the next year no problem
 - 2. Stop between 1 Feb and 1 March → Postponed BSA (Students can get a one-time extension. They still have to achieve it after 1 year
 - a. This gives students a bit more time to think if they want to continue
 - 3. After March → Regular BSA
 - ii. This rule will be implemented in the EER from next year but students from this year are still eligible for this.
- m. Schaafstal states that there are no updates on the TAO
- n. Schaafstal informs that they are going to investigate adding an AI track to CreaTe. For now, a Master track is being discussed but it would be nice to have something on AI at Bachelor's level.
- o. The collaboration between VU-UT is being re-thought. The collaboration should be more equal since there are now 1.5 years of experience
 - i. Question on opening Graduation Projects to all students (even VU students).
 As a starting point should be available for everyone
 - ii. M11 and M12 will not happen Q1/Q2 at VU since it doesn't make sense

- 5. Legality of re-election of PC members
 - a. Burema explains that once elected you can stay on, there is no need to be re-elected and that this is in part due to the information gap of knowledge needed to be in the PC.
 - b. Burema explains that she still needs to figure out the procedure of elections
 - Schaafstal suggests contacting Mirije van Dijk, Michel ten Bulte or the Secretariat from the Faculteitsbestuur
- 6. The overvieuw of the University structure (File 5a- 5c.) (File 6a- 6c.)
 - a. Burema sent all the documents. The documents are very long but some sections are quite common knowledge.
 - b. Zalewska asks Buser to change OLC to Program PC
 - c. Blom states he does not have access to this document

- 7. Low student attendance during lectures/ tutorials
 - a. Zalewska suggests that it is a common point that is discussed every year but that it is especially relevant at the VU
 - b. Buser asks if this trend is only for this it is only this period or throughout the year.

- c. Dertien suggests keeping track of attendance trends throughout the year to get a better idea in the future.
- d. Dertien suggests discussing this point at during the CRITEEC meetings
- e. If anyone wants to discuss this further they can add it on the agenda in the future.
- 8. EDI a whole storytelling course (improve the options for completing their storytelling pillar)
 - a. Houwelingen Snippe suggests that they want this course to be changed to a full storytelling pillar since 2 storytelling courses are disappearing. Currently it is half design/half storytelling. She states that van Delden and the I-tech board are on board with the idea
 - b. Schaafstal asks How does it affect the assessment criteria
 - Houwelingen Snippe explains that most of the grading was already focused on Storytelling
 - ii. Schaafstal suggests that the assessment should be fully assessed on storytelling.
 - c. Klein Brinke states that it is hard to provide feedback if the ILOs and assessment criteria is not known
 - d. Blom states that he took the course last year and that he felt that it was not full storytelling. He suggests that the course had some elements of storytelling, but it was only a part of the course.
 - e. Burema asks what the consequences of not changing this would be
 - i. Houwelingen Snippe explains that with the removal of 2 full storytelling courses the offer is very limited and since these courses tend to have limited capacity it makes it very hard for students to be able to choose.
 - f. Blom asks if other storytelling courses can increase the capacity
 - Houwelingen Snippe explains that they are trying to increase it but its dependent on teacher availability.
