PHD COURSE DESCRIPTION DATA MANAGEMENT (1,0 EC)

AFTER THIS COURSE YOU WILL BE ABLE TO:

- Write a data management plan (DMP) in accordance with your faculty's policy,
- · Apply data management practices to ensure verification and reuse in research, and
- Explain institutional and legal requirements related to the handling of research data (e.g. GDPR).

OPTION A: FULL COURSE RUN BY EXPERT TRAINERS (TOTAL WORKLOAD: 56 HOURS)

- Part 1: You complete the online self-study in the Canvas learning platform (approx. 20 hours). This includes writing the first
 draft of your data management plan, and
- Part 2: You attend the half day session with the trainer aimed at:
 - revising your draft data management plan based on feedback from the trainer,
 - sharing experiences with fellow course participants on data handling practices, and
 - discussing additional information about policies, procedures and best practices.

The course is attended by doctorate candidates of your own faculty and is taught by a data steward from your own faculty.

As completion evidence, you upload the course certificate into the doctoral monitoring system.
