Use of the AV Installation in a lecture hall



Press screen to start.

Use the lecture hall PC (CZ-PC) or connect your laptop with the use of the spider.

Selectable sources are PC, laptop (cabled or wireless), Digital Whiteboard (SMARTboard).

Green dot indicates that signal is present.

Presenting the desired source can be done by drag and drop icon to either or both screens on the touchpanel.

Output volume can be adjusted on the device.



Drag and drop AV Mute icon to temporarily mute image and sound. To unmute drag and drop the desired source icon to the screen area.



Shut down system by pressing power icon in upper right corner.

Connect the blue USB cable into the connector on the desk Turn on the CZ-PC Startup the AV system with the panel.



Use the Streamdeck to select Canvas
Log in with your credentials
Join the conference for this lecture



Do the microphone test
Press the telephone button



to select the appropriate microphone

- Press the camera button to select the webcam (you will see a preview)
 Use Start sharing to start your stream
 Use Start recording if you wish to record your lecture
- To end the lecture
 Stop the recording, if used
 Click on the 3 dots and select *End meeting*

Using lecture hall PC (CZ-PC) with Zoom

- Connect the blue USB cable into the connector on the desk Turn on the CZ-PC Startup the AV system with the panel.
- Use the Streamdeck to select Zoom Choose Join from Your Browser Log in with your credentials





- Permit to use the camera and click *Start Video* to select the camera Click on *Join Audio by computer* and give access to the microphone The " ^ " buttons allow you to select microphone and camera
- Use Share screen to start sharing your presentation Use Record if you wish to record your lecture



To end the lecture
Stop the recording, if used
Click on the 3 dots and select the red button End

Using lecture hall PC (CZ-PC) with MS-Teams

- Connect the blue USB cable into the connector on the desk Turn on the CZ-PC Startup the AV system with the panel.
 - STREAM DECK
- Use the Streamdeck to select Teams Log in with your UT-credentials



Open your meeting and start the lecture Select another camera or microphone by "..."



- Select to enter the sharing bar Use ... / Record if you wish to record your lecture
- To end the lecture Stop the recording, if used by ... / Stop recording Click on the red phone hook button to end the lecture


Using lecture hall PC (CZ-PC) for Recording

Connect the blue USB cable into the connector on the desk Turn on the CZ-PC Startup the AV system with the panel.



Use the Streamdeck to select Record The Streamdeck shows new buttons







- Press Record to start recording The Streamdeck will show the recording time Use Stop all to end your recording
- The file is stored on the desktop with a date and time stamp. Copy the file to an appropriate device Do not forget to delete permanently the file on the desktop (Shift Del)









Connect to the display wirelessly



Start-up AV system

- Start-up the AV system with the white touch panel on the desk.
- Drag and drop the wireless logo to the desired screen.
- Make wireless connection to AV system
 On the display & touchscreen, you will
 - On the display & touchscreen, you will find the URL or IP address of the AirMedia WiFi receiver. Enter the address or URL in your browser.
 - Mobile devices can share their content using Crestron AirMedia app (Google Play or App Store).
 - The browser shows the welcome screen. Press "Start Presenting".
 - If you do not have the AirMedia App already on your PC or Mac, you will be asked to install the app.
- Choose your receiver

 Run the client application. The Connect screen appears and lists any discovered AirMedia devices. Select *Connect* under the desired receiver or enter the device's IP address in the search bar & press enter.
- Start presenting
 - Enter the code shown on the **touch panel** in the lower left corner.
 - •Start sharing your screen.


Using the NewLine whiteboard

- Start-up the whiteboard
 - If the display is powered-off, press the on/off $^{\circ}$ button in the left down corner of the NewLine Display.
 - Press the Whiteboard button on the display. If it is not visible on the display, swipe the screen to the left.
 - You can raise or lower the display by using the triangular buttons.





Use the NewLine pencil to start writing on the display



- 4 move the canvas
- 5 select size and color of the pencil
- 2 menu to insert picture

- 9 erase parts of the screen
- 10 clear all data on this page
- 13 add a new page

Saving your work

- Tap 15 to get an overview of the pages in use on the Navigation window.
- •To save the whiteboard annotations, insert an FAT32 USB memory stick at the lower left corner backside of the display.
- On the bottom of the Navigation window, press the USB stick button to save the image on the stick.



Using your laptop with the lecture hall webcam



Connect the blue USB cable to your laptop Startup the AV system with the panel.

- Startup your laptop
- Startup the software on the laptop you want to use with the webcam
- 3
- Select the appropriate camera in your software (Logitech 930)
- 4
- Select the appropriate microphone in your software

Use the microphone of your laptop or select the UMC202HD for the Revolabs wearable microphone (if available)

Select the Logitech 930 microphone only if no better microphone is available



To end the lecture

Disconnect the blue USB cable

Put the Revolabs microphone into the charger, it fits one way (if used)

Shut down the AV system

Connect Spotlight to your device (Bluetooth)

Attention: only works if the lecture hall PC (CZ-PC) is turned off

On Windows 10

- 1. Select the Windows icon, then select Settings
- 2. Select Devices, then Bluetooth in the left pane
- 3. Put the Spotlight in pairing mode, by pressing the Cursor [2] and Back [4] simultaneously until the Spotlight vibrates
- 4. Press Add Bluetooth or other devices, select Bluetooth and select the Spotlight device and select Done

On Mac OS X

- 1. Select the Systems Preferences and click Bluetooth
- 2. Put the Spotlight in pairing mode, by pressing the Cursor [2] and Back [4] simultaneously until the Spotlight vibrates
- 3. Select the Logitech device from the Devices and select Pair
- 4. Follow the on-screen instructions to finish pairing
