

Update Project Optimisation Mobility Online

While there is certainly progress in some parts of the optimisation project, it was decided to extend the duration to (at least) the end of June 2023. It was decided that an extension is necessary due to the fact that development capacity at LISA is only available as of this February, rather than initially hoped in the fall of 2022.

So far the workload overview as well as several aspects of improving the incoming pipelines have been completed. The connection between AFAS and Mobility-Online has been thoroughly tested and implementing it to import the UT employees as supervisors is being scheduled for late February / early March.

The other aspects of this connection (importing departments and marking persons as inactive in case the employment has been terminated) are still in development in the test environment. Staff Mobility for outgoing teaching or training trips has been implemented and the user acceptance test are taking place as we speak. More details regarding this as well as manuals etc to follow in the next newsletter.

The functional design of the Mobility-Online Connector (MO Connector), which will replace all current connections with other systems, has been signed off and as soon as a developer is available from LISA the actual realization will start. Digital Learning Agreement (DLA) – formerly known as Online Learning Agreement: DLA is part of Erasmus Without Paper (EWP) and means that the courses a student wants to take at a host institution are shared digitally. Signing off on the course package no longer happens on a print out, but digitally. Regardless of which mobility systems are used by the institutions. Changes to the course package can be done in the during phase as well.
