TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

Your Transcript of Records will be generated from OSIRIS automatically and will be sent to you approximately five weeks after your last exam.

In order to receive the correct version, please pay attention to the following:

1. Keep an eye on your results in OSIRIS.
2. Make sure you are NOT registered for any courses for which you have not done any type of exam / are not planning to do an exam.
3. If some marks are still missing three weeks after the end of the semester, contact the relevant lecturer and explain that you are an exchange student who needs the results because of the Transcript of Records.
4. If some marks are still missing four weeks after the end of the semester, contact your Exchange Coordinator so that they can stop your Transcript of Records from being generated incorrectly.

You must finish your entire workflow in Mobility Online - this includes uploading your final signed Learning Agreement. You only receive a Transcript of Records once your workflow has been finalised.
