General Teamcher Responsibilities

- Be available and on site for the full duration of the programme
- Mentor a team of students throughout the entire challenge: organize check-up points with them, provide continuous feedback and guidance to participants
- Align the method of teaching and the course content with ECIU's mission, values, and goals

General Workshop Facilitator Responsibilities

 Conduct an engaging 2-3 hour session that fosters interactive learning and active participation on their subject of expertise, and lead a workshop on a specific subject for all participants

Practicalities

You will be paid for the mobility to Lodz covering your **1)** travel to and from Lodz, Poland, **2)** accommodation from Sunday night November 30th until Saturday morning December 6th, and **3)** food expenses during the week. Alternatively, as we have only 4-funded spots, we would be happy to host more staff, but you would need to utilize Erasmus+ Staff Mobility funding if possible at your institution.

Be advised that teaching time will not be covered from this opportunity.

While we would ideally have Teamchers that also provide the Workshops, we also understand this may be difficult for time/schedule, so if you are only able/interested in fulfilling one of the roles, please sign up and let us know!

Sessions

Design Thinking

Working as a student ambassador requires you to be creative and to think outside the box, while creating solutions for specific needs. Design Thinking is a practical and collaborative methodology that supports this mindset and equips students with tools to understand problems deeply, ideate effectively, and test solutions iteratively. Ambassadors will often engage in projects requiring problem-solving, empathy, and co-creation with stakeholders from across the ECIU network.

This session should prepare them to apply the Design Thinking process in real-world ambassador activities and enhance their ability to approach challenges creatively and systematically. We are searching for someone who has:

- Practical experience in applying **Design Thinking**, human-centered design, or similar innovation methodologies
- Ability to facilitate interactive, hands-on sessions that engage students in active learning
- Familiarity with **Challenge-Based Learning (CBL)** and integrating Design Thinking within educational contexts

 Strong background in creativity development, problem-solving strategies, and group facilitation

Leadership

Student Ambassadors will have to lead and work on projects during their mandate. Most of these require project and team management skills and put them in the role of leader. They will conduct these projects in teams of ambassadors, working with each other and with universities and ECIU staff members.

This session should prepare them to take this role of leader and facilitate their journey in project management. We are searching for someone who has:

- Strong background in **leadership development**, student engagement, and organizational skills.
- Experience in **coaching, mentoring, or training students** in leadership roles
- Familiarity with Challenge-Based Learning (CBL) and other innovative teaching methodologies
- Awareness of international and intercultural dynamics in leadership, particularly within the context of higher education.
- Knowledge of stakeholder engagement, decision-making strategies, and project management in student-led initiatives

Pitching/Presentation/ Entrepreneurship/communication

Student ambassadors need to be able to communicate innovatively and efficiently to communities to promote ECIU and its Learning Opportunities to students. They are also directly in contact with administrative staff, teachers and university employees. Their role is also to ensure communication between these communities and the students. They need to be able to deliver the right message understandably and efficiently.

This session will be dedicated to preparing them to pitch/present their ideas and projects at the end of the 5 days in teams.

We are searching for someone who has:

- Strong background in communication, speech, presentation and pitch preparation
- Experience in coaching, mentoring, or training students in communication
- Familiarity with Challenge-Based Learning (CBL) and other innovative teaching methodologies
- Awareness of international and intercultural dynamics in communication, particularly within the context of higher education and considering aspects such as intercultural competences
