- Supporting staff in faculties and service departments with grant writing and communiqués through professional editing and translation services and partners.
- Advising the University of Twente on issues relating to language policy.

The UT Language Centre works in a flexible and professional manner within a continuously evolving digital era, taking the individual learner as the starting point and offering tailored advice on how best to improve one's proficiency and skills. The language and skills teachers working at or for the UT Language Centre are qualified and experienced higher education professionals. The UT Language Centre additionally hires and trains student workers to assist with meeting learner needs through our course offer, workshops, and individual support services, thereby providing opportunities for students to develop professional skills.
