Next, the interface with JOIN will be developed as part of the DSD project. As the development progresses, we will keep you updated.

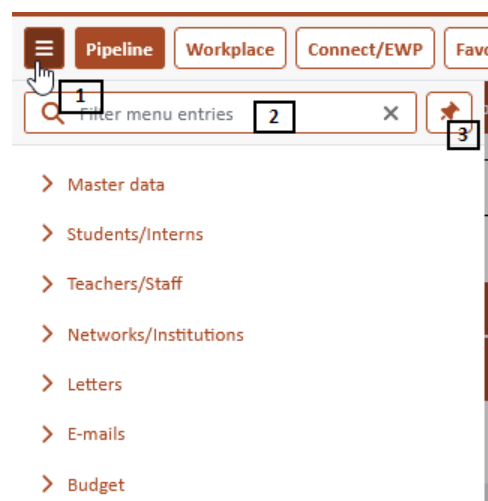
New Pipeline Layout

Dutch version below

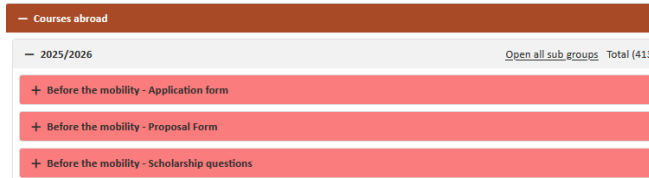
Below we shortly explain what changes you can expect from the new pipeline layout. You can also find this information on our website, as one of the FAQs. For those who prefer a Dutch explanation, we have added it at the end of this newsletter.

Some features have been added to increase the user-friendliness of the system. The screenshots below have been taken from the test environment, which is the reason the main colour scheme is in brown. The production environment is still in the colour scheme you are used to, no worries there.

The menu is now collapsible (1), thus making your screen cleaner and giving you more space to view the pipeline. You can search within the menu (2) and should you prefer to have the menu visible at all times you can click on the icon to the very right (3) to pin it in place.



As you can see below, all lines have become tighter. The link to open all steps at once has been moved to the right. The same is true for the icon to view all applications at once regardless of the step they are in.



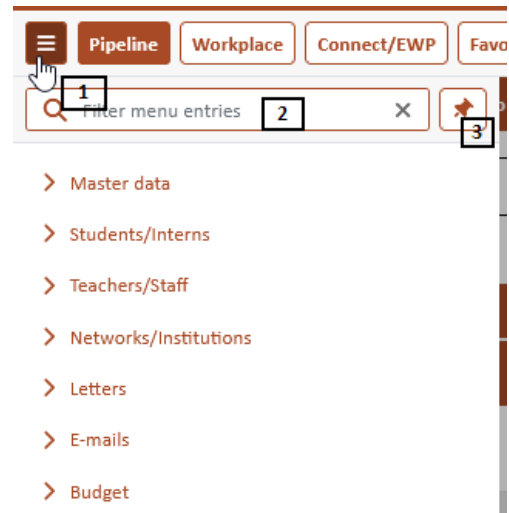
Within the sub-categories the icons indicating new applications in a step have become a little smaller, yet the question mark icon has become more visible on the line.



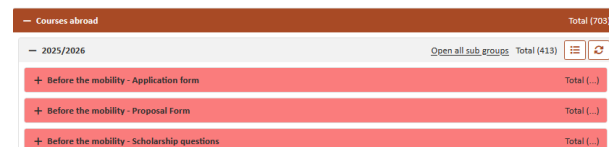
Wat houdt de nieuwe pipeline layout nu precies in en wat kunnen jullie ervan verwachten?

Er zijn features om de gebruiksvriendelijkheid te verbeteren. De afbeeldingen zijn van de testomgeving, daarom zijn de algemene achtergrondkleuren bruin, in de productieomgeving is alles nog steeds in het kleurenschema dat jullie gewend zijn. 😊

Het menu is nu inklapbaar (1), waardoor je scherm overzichtelijker wordt en je meer ruimte overhoudt voor de pipeline zelf. Jullie kunnen binnen het menu zoeken (2) en mocht je het prettiger vinden om het menu toch altijd uitgeklaapt te hebben, kun je op het icoontje helemaal rechts (3) klikken.



Zoals jullie hieronder kunnen zien, is alles iets strakker geworden. De link om alle stappen in één keer uit te vouwen is verplaatst naar rechts, net als de mogelijkheid om alle applicaties te bekijken ongeacht in welke stap deze staan.



In de sub categorieën zijn de iconen voor de nieuwe applicaties per stap iets kleiner geworden, maar het vraagteken icoon springt er juist iets meer uit.
