

- aim: accelerate the transition to Open Access
- publications based on research resulting from Horizon Europe calls as of 2021
 - peer reviewed publications
- books, long-text formats
 - CC-BY, CC-BY-ND (exception), CC-BY-NC (exception)
- articles, reviews, conference papers, book chapters
 - CC-BY
 - <u>DOAJ</u>-listed journal (OA Gold)
 - transformative journal (OA Hybrid)




- No deal → alternative funding
 - Allocate budget for APCs in your EU grant (only full Gold)
 - local deals (e.g. SpringerOpen, BMC, ACM)
 - faculty OA fund
 - research budget

 - 1. author agrees with funder's demand that research outcomes will be published immediately in Open Access
 - 2. upon submission author informs publisher of using RRS
 - Statement in publication (acknowledgments)
 - 3. this agreement is prior to copyright transfer agreement with publisher
 - 4. upon publication author makes article Open Access available in institution repository
 - Version of Record (VoR: published version: preferred) or Author Accepted Manuscript (AAM: postprint)
 - CC-BY (preferred) or CC-BY-ND
