

Master's programme Psychology 2024-2025

The Master's programme in Psychology (60EC, 1 year) offers five (specialisation) tracks in the field of psychology:

- Conflict, Risk & Safety
- Educational Psychology
- Health Psychology & Technology
- Human Factors & Engineering Psychology
- Positive Clinical Psychology & Technology

The language of communication, instruction and examination in the MSc programme Psychology is English. This means that in all tracks/specialisations:

- Study materials are in English.
- Classes (lectures, seminars, workshops, practicals, and others) are taught in English*.
- Exams and assignments are composed in English and students have to complete all exams and assignments in English*/**.
- Presentations (including the master's thesis presentation) have to be prepared in English.

* In the master's specialisation Positive Clinical Psychology & Technology Dutch (speaking) students have the possibility to practise, get feedback on, and do assignments in (counselling) skills in Dutch during some practical/clinical courses.

** For the internship part of the master's programme deviation of this rule is allowed in case (writing) the internship in English is impossible due to the nature of the (Dutch) internship organization. It is then allowed to compose the internship product and/or report in Dutch.

Students can start the master(tracks) in September or February. The programme as determined for students starting in February (2025) can be found in this document.

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Conflict, Risk & Safety (CRS)

The master track CRS consists of four obligatory courses (20EC) and one elective course (5EC). The track will be completed with a Master's Thesis and Internship. The student conducts a master's thesis of 25EC. The Internship (external or internal) consists of 10EC.

¹ The Internship in the master is mandatory. When an Internship of 19EC is done, the student conducts a Master's Thesis of 14EC. If a student opts for an Internship of 10EC, a Master's Thesis of 23EC is carried out. Please note that in this latter case the internship takes place in 1B. ² There are three types of internships PCPT: 'Clinical Internship PCPT', 'Research/Education Internship PCPT' & 'Prevention Internship PCPT'. For the Clinical Internship PCPT the obligatory prerequisites are: at least grade 5.5 for the course 'Positive Clinical Psychology' and actively participated (participated in lectures and exams) in the course 'Positive Cognitive Behavioural Therapy'.
