



## Flash information on the results of a call for proposals

The Research Executive Agency, assisted by independent experts, has now completed the evaluation of proposals submitted to the above call. The names of all the experts used in relation to this theme will be published on the Participants Portal, on an annual basis.

The results of the evaluation by experts are summarised below:

Number of proposals submitted:	330
Number of ineligible proposals:	1
Number of withdrawn proposals:	3
Number of proposals receiving an evaluation score above the applicable threshold:	168
Total requested EU contribution from these above-threshold proposals:	€ 671 636 644

Applicants will be informed of the evaluation scores and comments relating to their own proposals.

The number of proposals that can finally be funded depends on the available budget, the outcome of negotiations, and the completion of the formal procedures. It is expected that the first grant agreements with successful applicants will be concluded by December 2012.
