Compensation grants you EC's for a course (\leq 5 EC) with grade 5 in Osiris, or 4.8 – 5.4 before rounding. Check the conditions below and think about the consequences for your study plan. If in doubt, or if you failed more courses than can be compensated, discuss your plan with the study adviser. When ready, answer the questions below in Adobe Reader, save an unsigned copy, and sign digitally. Send the signed PDF to <u>BEX-AT@utwente.nl</u>. First-year students should only do this when all resits and repairs in M1 - M4 have been graded.

The following rules apply. (Students in the 2013-2019 AT programme should consult BEX Rules and Regulations 11.3 instead.) - Compensation can only be requested for a complete study unit (with a course code in Osiris), not for a component of a study unit.

- A compensated course appears on the AT diploma with a 'C5' code, and you cannot graduate "cum laude" with a C5.

- If you switch to another programme than AT, their Examination Board has the option to reject transfer of the compensated course. - At most two C5's are allowed, and not both for first-year courses of the same BSA category (e.g., two first-year mathematics courses).

- To compensate the 5, you need other grades that are high enough to ensure that the average of all your grades in AT (EC-weighted) is at least 6.000. For example, this can be achieved by having a 7 for another course with at least as many EC's as the compensated course. (How to calculate the average AT grade if you have not completed all courses? Assume a 6.0 for all courses you still have to complete, because 6.0 is the lowest passing grade.)
