Advice on forms to determine grades for the bachelor assignments involving AM

In general we are positive about the three forms as presented. They make clear to lecturers what aspects count and how to motivate the grade. We have one specific suggestion though for the double programme APh-AM.

The description of the test scheme and relative weights for the learning goals are fine and clear. But, while this is certainly the administrative basis, they leave too much room for personal interpretation for grading the bachelor project. Lecturers will not be able to state such sub-grades with precise percentages. Within TNW a table has been developed as proper guide to lecturers to decide upon a grade in a substantiated way. This table has been adopted by several programmes and is used by AM and AM-CS too. We recommend this table form to be part of the grading form.
