Advice Bachelor-TER 2019-2020 for AM

The programme committee has discussed the B-TER for next academic year. In general, we think the TER is fine and agree with the small changes made. We noticed a few minor points regarding wording that have been changed on the spot, together with the PD. There were, however, a few bigger issues regarding the programme specific part.

- 1. In Table 1 there is a change of ECs that was not discussed previously by the PC. We agree with the PD that the shift in the first module regarding Prooflab is merely a cosmetic change, and this is ok.
- 2. The change in module 3 is more problematic as it anticipates a plan that is not concrete as of yet. This concerns changing Presentation Skills to 2 EC, and using the 1 EC for programming that still needs to be developed. We disagree with approving this change. Instead, after discussion with the PD, we agree allocating this 1 EC to programming if it teaches the Mathematica practicals as they were taught up to two years ago in this combined AP-AM-module. If something else is taught, this should be discussed first with the PC.
- 3. As Presentation Skills is not part of the core of the module, a pass or grade for this subject should be valid indefinitely. This should be stated correctly in section 3.7 and 4.3.
- 4. In the double degree programme with AP, on p34 section 2, the sum of the ECs should be correct.

Given the above considerations and changes as discussed with the PD, we give a positive advice.
