Double degree UT-UGM

The OLC advises positively about the double degree UT-UGM. The OLC would like to see the following improvements in the final version of the document:

- 1. The double-degree programme seems to be designed mainly for the Indonesian students. It is important to make it clear how students from The Netherlands can participate in this programme.
- 2. The OLC supports that students joining the programme should already have their internship arranged. The OLC encourages to look actively for possible internships for students specializing in SACS.
- 3. The requirement to have an internship report and the final project on a level of a scientific publication is beyond the requirements for a MSc degree. The OLC suggests to rephrase these formulations. For example, the requirement can be on the focus (e.g. more medical for internship and more mathematical for the final project) and the form of the report (e.g. write a report in a form of scientific publication).
- 4. The document contains many inconsistencies, the text has to be verified and proofread thoroughly.
