Advice Master EER AM 2022-2023, final version

Dear Programme Director,

We acknowledge there was yet another update of the Master EER after our last meeting on 22 June 22. We have read this version and acknowledge that our suggestions have been adopted, as well as some changes suggested by the Faculty council. We note the following points.

- 1 Article B4.2 Year 2 no longer lists the "Internship for AM" as in earlier versions. This must be an editorial mistake made when inserting the heading "Course code, Name, ECs, Period ". We expect this to be inserted again.
- 2 We observe the difference in article B6.2 regarding the Graduation Committee, which no longer states a senior examiner has to be chairholder. There is some inconsistency however as article B1.1 still states the Graduation supervisor has to be a chair holder, there is some inconsistency. We suggest B1.1 to be updated.
- 3 We have asked multiple times but have not yet seen a Course Proposal Capita Selecta related to our earlier discussion. The reference to the Master AM website is appropriate for now for the EER, but to enable students to use this option to complete their course list, we encourage you to create this course quickly in the fall of 2022.
- 4 We approve the change that the chairs are no longer listed for the three specialisations. On the one hand, this change is good, while on the other hand the procedure of choosing a chair and graduation supervisor and senior examiner is not there. Nor is it clear that these may be different. This procedure may be clarified on the website.
