# Minutes 179th PC-AM-meeting Tuesday 15 November 2022, 15:45-16:45 hr Ravelijn 3411

1. Opening

The chairman opens the meeting at 15.46.
2. Minutes 178 th meeting $\mathbf{2 0}$ September 2022

Page 1 Line 33: Cannot should be one word

Page 2 Line 65: Geerts asks, instead of Sem
Line 76: Instead of the current sentence: Lecturers felt like the module comments were not helpful

Line 131: The formulation should change to this: First, the schedule is very tight. It is not that the programme does not want to publish the EER, but it first has to be approved by the PC and then the faculty council. This whole procedure takes a lot of time.
If there are no changes to the EER, then it is possible to publish it in April, however, last year it was unfeasible due to the changes in the AM Bachelor programme.
Line 136: Feedback should end up with the person responsible
Page 4 Line 151: Freshman singular, should be plural
Page 5 Line 219: from Abacus should be by Abacus
With these changes, the minutes are adopted.

In the previous meeting, it was established that the Canvas page designed to communicate with the teachers of AM did not include all staff members. The chairman asks whether the Canvas page is actually used. The B-coordinator says that the PD first

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wants to investigate whether the teachers still look at it since many teachers have their Canvas notifications turned off. Therefore writing an announcement there would not be effective. It has the attention of the B-coordinator and the PD.

The B-coordinator mentions that Goseling is on sick leave. By now perhaps Boucherie or Walter is taking over the topic of computing clusters. Manthey says that Mathias Walter knows everything about the clusters. The chairman adds that Walter is also involved

The chairman has spent time with Walter, who then rephrased the learning goals. Walter has sent the learning goals to the PD and the chairman.

The PD says that because of circumstances, Introduction to PDE will be taught the same way this year as last year. There will be another teacher to help to redesign the course for next year.
The action point regarding the course proposal for CS has not been done yet.
The M-coordinator thinks that it has no consequences for the students yet.

The B-coordinator mentions that it has been discussed with the module coordinator. Since the resits of the courses will be in the next module, this part is solved. The teachers for module 3 will be the same as the teachers of module 4 from last year.

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The chairman has discussed it with the administrator and Luijten. He is not per se against hybrid meetings. It takes a lot of time to arrange a suitable hybrid meeting. Manthey is in favour of just using the replacement rule, that is, if you cannot make it, just find a replacement. It is interesting for other colleagues to join from time to time. He also feels that if he is on the online end of the meeting, he is not really participating. The members of the PC agree that a hybrid meeting is not the preferred way of working, so it will not happen anymore. Instead, the replacement rule will be advocated.

5. Evaluation reports bachelor courses

- Module 3 2021-2022, reflection of the module team This module is not going to be taught anymore, so it will not be discussed further.
- Module 7 2021-2022, reflection of the module team

The chairman thinks that it is a thoughtful reflection. However, he sees that they would like to change a few things that he thinks should go via the PC. The chairman received an email from Uetz who would like to change two courses. The text that he provided was not specific enough and also not discussed with the PD.
The chairman wants to point out one particular topic. Uetz wrote that he thinks that the topic of planar graphs and generating functions are rather isolated and does not reoccur in the programme. However, generating functions are used in Probability Theory and ODE. He wants the PD to be aware of this.
Thus, the module team of module 7 have some ideas to improve their courses, but they first have to discuss them with the PD.

- Module 4 2021-2022, evaluation report 2

The comments were mostly about communication and timely grading. By shifting module 4 to quartile 3 and by taking the resits to the next module, these topics will be solved. Hence the new curriculum takes care of that. The last day of the academic year is still a working day, so resits can be scheduled on that day.

- Module 8 2021-2022, evaluation report 2

Proksch mentions that the Applied Mathematics students thought the shared courses were too easy. The chairman asks in what way the project is going to change. Is the nature of the project or the objective of the project going to change? Since the collaborative part is taken out, the chairman thinks it is wise to discuss the new set-up of the project with the PC.
The PD says that he has not heard from the teachers to what extent they want to change this module, but it is good to discuss the project with the PC. Indeed, math students find the joined courses too easy. In what sense will that be addressed this year when the

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courses are not together? The same goes for the project. He has not heard anything about changing the learning objectives.
The chairman proposes sending an email to Scheinhardt as module coordinator, saying that the PC would like to see what will change.

Action point: Chairman
Send an email to Scheinhardt as module coordinator, saying that the PC would like to see what will change.

The PD says that in the Python course, it is not taught how to exploit multi-processors. The person formally responsible for the clusters is Boucherie. Walter does the communication, so practical issues should be communicated with Walter. He thinks that the students should know how to use Python on multi-processor infrastructure. This is also something to communicate since it will be added in modules 7 or 8 . We have servers available but right now the students do not know how to use them. The chairman says that module 7 would be the logical time to teach it. The PD adds that the servers have been ordered.

- Module 12 2021-2022, evaluation report 2

The chairman is happy to see that How to write a scientific paper on Mathematical Research 2 will be taken over by a math teacher. The B-coordinator agrees. The Bcoordinator contacted the authors of the panel evaluation report. There is especially one paragraph that was not the way she worded it (old document page 21, second paragraph). "The B-coordinator thinks that the second examinator should have little to no knowledge of the student's progress." This should be changed to "need not have". She conveyed this to the authors. The wording in the evaluation was also not great since she and them were used unclearly. It was sometimes not clear who was meant, the students or the B-coordinator.

The chairman starts the discussion about supervisors being present at the final presentation. Being ill of course happens, but he believes that there is a second category of people that just do not come. The B-coordinator knows of situations where indeed the supervisor was not present. The chairman asks the students what they think about this. Lanting says that in her experience if the supervisor could not be there, he would discuss it with the second corrector that one of them would be there. The PD thinks that both should be present at the final presentation. Apparently, the final presentation is not a priority and that is unacceptable. The chairman asks if there should there be consequences. The PD knows who was not present. The PD says that the teachers should definitely be informed that they should be there in principle. The last two years were strange due to corona, but this year, those kinds of excuses are no longer there.

Action point: B-coordinator
Look into the matter of supervisors not being present and inform the teachers.

- Module 1 2022-2023, evaluation report 1

The chairman asks the students what they hear the freshmen say about module 1. Lanting says that they find Analysis 1 very confusing, in particular, they complain about

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the style of the lectures. Van der Veer says that they think that there are a lot of proofs of the week, and the timing of the POW is suboptimal. The workload is not well divided over the week, especially in the beginning.
The chairman talked to Perez-Arancibia, and he recognized this. For some students to become mature is a journey. For some students, the distinction between Calculus and Analysis could have been better. The chairman furthermore comments that he reads that there is a particular tutor that is not adhering to the guidelines laid out by the teachers. Thus the teaching is not aligned for all students. His suggestion to the programme management is that the module team should plan a meeting to discuss this. It needs to be streamlined since it is taught for the first time.

- Module 5 2022-2023, evaluation report 1

The chairman says that students complain about handing in homework on paper, but there are also advantages to writing it down. Lanting says that this evaluation sounds rather positive compared to what she has heard from the students. Boon says that there will probably be more on this topic.

7. $A O B$ / Questions before closing the meeting

The B-coordinator asks the chairman what the procedure is for stepping down as chairman.
The chairman also has a question. He was listening to a colleague that got hold of the UT proposal for the RompOER. It said that passing would no longer be a 5.50 but a 5.51 . It definitely matters, so he wants the PD to be aware of this topic. The PD has not heard anything about this.
Later, the B-coordinator adds that the passing grade stays a 5.50.

The chairman says that formally his term as chairman ends by the end of the calender year. Who will be the new chairman?
Lanting asks if a student can become a chairman. It is indeed possible. She asks what happens if a student is not available for the entire year. The chairman thinks that is very inconvenient. Since no one currently wants to step up as chairman, the chairman will continue to be chairman. The PD says that if we want the students to have a chance to become chairman, it would be more natural to appoint a chairman at the start of the academic year.
The chairman says in the rules it is stated that the PC-AM chooses a chairman for a period of a year. He proposes to appoint him until September. Then at the beginning of September, the chairman situation can be rediscussed.
