

Advies Evaluation Module 4



The OLC has discussed the evaluations of Module 4 Applied Mathematics in 2015/16. The OLC notices that there were several consistent points of criticism by the students. The OLC advises to improve Module 4 next year by addressing the following points.

- The students mention communication problems during the module. According to many students, the information was often unclear, and available too late. The OLC urges the organizers of the module to improve this point.
- The AM students had a feeling that the course “wetenschapsfilosofie” was mainly focusing on the topics in physics. Same concern was expressed about the project. The students would like to see more focus on mathematics. The OLC advises to address the balance between physics and mathematics.
- The attendance of presentations “wetenschapsfilosofie” was optional, which resulted to low attendance. The OLC advises to improve that by giving students more incentive for better attendance. This is also related to the previous point, that is, the subjects of the presentations should be made more interesting for math students.
