



Dear dean, dear Faculty Board,




In the beginning of March 2018, you asked for our advice about the proposed profile on the structure and profile report for the full professorship 'Institutional Aspects of (Higher) Education & Technology'. When giving consent on structure-reports, the Faculty Council of BMS focusses on at least the following four topics;

- I. Does the structure-report fit in the general strategy as adopted by the faculty and are the relevant members of the faculty involved in developing the structure-report?
- II. Does the position as indicated in the structure-report fit the long term financial planning of the faculty?
- III. Are the mandatory elements of the report, as indicated in the brochure about appointing chairs (<https://www.utwente.nl/nl/hr/loopbaan/talentontwikkeling/2213-hooglerarenbrochure.pdf>, especially appendix 5) adequately developed?
- IV. Are the procedure (open and closed, see also the aforementioned brochure) and the recruitment committee (BAC) sufficiently clear, adequately defended and do these aspects meet the relevant criteria?

In our meeting on the 22nd of March, 2018 we discussed the structure report. We concluded that the structure-report fits in the general strategy as adopted by the faculty and was developed in close coordination with those currently developing the 'learning' theme. The position was already announced and planned in the long-term planning of the faculty and since this is an open procedure and a BAC was mentioned in the report, we have no reason to believe that the procedural requirements are not met.

Therefore, the council advises positively on the structure report as sent to the council.
