

General comments from the Exam Board Management Sciences  
On the BA program specific EER 2017-2018

- 1) To clarify the EER and connected documents/regulations for all users, the Examination Board Management Sciences advises a consistent use of definitions, to take the definitions in the EER as a basis. (for example: Chapter 3 of PSA BA -> the word Examination is used, where in EER this is defined as Final Degree Audit.)
- 2) In the exam formats of the Master courses no percentage is mentioned regarding the weight of specific tests and/or exams. The Examination Board would advise the Programme Director (PD) to make this information transparent.
- 3) Art. 4e mentions the tasks of the program(me) committee. The Examination Board advises to extend the mentioned tasks with the new formal task:  
*to advise (the programme director) on stimulating and ensuring the quality of the degree programme* (WHW art. 9.18)
- 4) Jurisdiction of the Programme Director vs the Examination Board:  
Art. 6b. par 3. states that if the student does not agree with the decision of the programme director, he should lodge an appeal with the Complaints' Desk, not to the Examination Board. The Examination Board advises to change this in the Programme Specific Appendix
- 5) For consideration, also according to issue 5 of this advice: Thesis 6b.5 - if a student takes too much time to finish his thesis, not the Program Director but the examiner should terminate the project.
