Below I am sending you the advice from the Examination Board (or Boards BMS?) Management Sciences regarding the BMS Examination and Education Regulation (EER).

Art. 4.3a – the Examination Boards suggest to remove this paragraph to prevent students to become motivated to send in requests to the Examination Board regarding the public character of the thesis. Overall BMS policy is that the thesis is public.

Art. 4.2 Modules – To avoid confusion in definitions the Examination Boards suggest to remove this article as there are no modules but courses in the MSc programmes.

Art. 8.7 The hardship clause, to clarify jurisdiction of Programme Directors vs Examination Boards in addressing this clause, we suggest to add the last sentence of the EER BSC (in Dutch: “Leidend daarbij is welk gremium (examencommissie of opleidingsbestuur) volgens deze regeling de taak of bevoegdheid heeft om een beslissing te nemen over of een uitzondering te maken op een bepaling uit deze regeling”.)

In English: In decision making the gremia (Programme Director or Examination Board) that has the formal task or jurisdiction according to this regulation to decide on an exception based on this article, will handle the case.

I hope you will take our advice into account in decision making of the Faculty Council on July 10th, 2017 regarding the EER.
