Call for papers for the Special Session on Entrepreneurship Education

Dear colleague,

I'm pleased to share with you the call for papers of the **High Technology Small Firms (HTSF) Conference** that will be held at the **University of Twente on 27-28 May 2019**.

This year the HTSF Conference dedicates a **special session** on **Entrepreneurship Education**. This special session is part of the **4TU Entrepreneurship Education Research group**. In this session, we focus on unique, innovative and practically applicable research, practices and insights into the antecedents, processes and outcomes of entrepreneurship education at the school, higher education, and corporate levels.

Entrepreneurship Education is in line with the "third mission" of universities, in particular in fostering the societal impact generated by promoting entrepreneurship at many levels. The entrepreneurship education research agenda is indicative of a vibrant field and suggests research on novel forms of impact (mind-set, emotion, self-image), complex contextualizations (person-, context-, and pedagogical moderators), and novel didactical methods (e.g. lean startup, effectuation).¹ In that respect, we welcome abstracts of papers related to topics like the following (indicative topics):
