The Financial Stability Research Group at the University of Twente conducts research on how financial stability is supplied internationally, nationally, and at the European level. Courses for graduate students are offered as part of the one-year Master of Science Programme in Public Administration / European Studies, with the option of an 18-month dual degree offered jointly by Twente and the Department of Political Science at the University of Muenster.

The Financial Stability Research Group offers students a unique opportunity to conduct thesis and other research in a group setting of students with similar interests, under the guidance of experienced and expert staff. The group meets regularly in both semesters.
