

Evaluation report: Clinical Rehabilitation and Technology – 2013/2014

The evaluation committee has evaluated the course Clinical Rehabilitation and Technology by sending an online questionnaire to 132 students. 23 students filled in the questionnaire, which gives a response of 17%.

This course scores in general 3.5, which is sufficient for a master course (3.5). Most of the grades the course received are within the 3-4 range. Respondents agreed the most with the question 'The contents of the course are interesting' (3.8). The course was also suitable for self-study (3.7) and the teacher was available for questions (3.7)

Respondents said that the level of the course was a bit low, and that it wasn't worth the 5 EC. Although the lectures were interesting, they weren't needed for the final assignment. Respondents also said that they would appreciate it if the goal for the final assignment was made clear in the first lecture.

These are the main conclusions of the evaluation. The interpretation is based on the remarks of the respondents. For an overview of the results, see the graph at the end of this report.

Recommendations of last evaluation

No previous report was found. It is therefore not possible to state the recommendations of the last evaluation.

Recommendations by the committee:

The quality of the course can be improved. Based on the results of the questionnaire, some recommendations for improvement are provided. The most important recommendations are:

- Explain the goal for the final assignment in the first lecture. Respondents said that handing out the assignment in the third lecture made attending the first two pointless
- Try to make a connection between the final assignment and the lectures. Respondents noted that there was no need to follow the lectures to pass the course. Maybe consider making a small exam about the lectures.

Overview:

- Most marks are given on a Likert-scale from 1-5. For master courses, a mark of 3.5 or higher is sufficient.
- The height of the bars in the graph represents the mark. The thin line at the top of the bars gives the standard deviation.

Explanation of marks:

- Total 'first impression rating' is the mark given to the question: Overall appreciation.
- Ability to study is the average point of the marks given to the part of study material.
- Relevancy is the mark given to the question: Relevancy of the course.
- Quality of education is the average point of the marks given to the parts "lectures" and "practices".
- Coordination / Planning is the average point of the marks of "Adequate Information on Blackboard" and "Teacher available for questions".
- Examination / Assignments is the average point of the marks given to the Examination /Final Assignment part.
- Average is the mean of all given marks.
