

Evaluation report Simulation

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The evaluation committee has evaluated the course Simulations by evaluating the SEQ questionnaire which was sent to 76 students. 26 students filled in the questionnaire, which gives a response of 34.2%.

The course Simulation scores a 4.2 which is good for a master course. The statements 'The teacher demonstrated to be a content expert' and 'The course topics we're relevant for the programme' score the best with respectively a 4.8 and 4.7. The statements 'The work load was well spread over the entire course' scored the lowest with a 3.6, which is still sufficient. Students think the effort demanded in this course is worth more EC's compared with other course of the same amount of EC's. The students are very content with the course, but they do have a suggestion for improvement. The student think it would be useful to discuss the assignments in class or do a peer review in order to gain more insight in the topic.

These are the main conclusions of the evaluation. The interpretation is based on the remarks of the respondents.

Recommendations of previous evaluation

There was no previous evaluation. It is therefore not possible to state the recommendations of the last evaluation.

Recommendations by the committee

The quality of the course can be improved. Based on the results of the questionnaire, some recommendations for improvement are provided. The most important recommendations are:

- Reconsider the amount of EC's stated for the course.
- Organize peer review or feedback sessions. Students think these would be useful and could increase their knowledge.
- Keep up the good work.
