Minutes 233rd Education Committee 11 October 2017

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1. Opening

In absence of the chairman and student chairman, dr. G.G.M. Stoffels will act as chairman for this meeting. The chairman opens the meeting at 10:06

Page 1: no comments.

Page 2: E. van der Weide asks for the numbers of people that didn't get a positive BSA. G. Stoffels says that out of 120 students 60 got a positive advice, 5 got a positive advice after reconsideration, 16 got a postponed advice due to circumstances, 24 got a negative advice and 15 quit before an advice was given. So about one third of the students quit.

M. van Bergen asks if these results are within the new "pass-fail" regulation.

G. Stoffels explains that it was with the old regulation and that the students were allowed to have one 5 or a 4 for modelling and programming. However these results can't be compared to the new regulation. One third of the students already has 60 EC, but the average grade is lower and there are no very high scoring students (9, 10 on average). Only one student has

L. Gommer asks about the current first years. G. Stoffels says that it is too early to draw any

conclusions, but 8 students already quit and one transferred from EE.

E. van der Weide inquires if the introduction of English has any effect. B. van Eijk thinks not,

but M. van Bergen disagrees. No conclusion is reached.

M. van Bergen points to a mistake in the minutes, regarding the module nomenclature. A short discussion follows and it is decided to use the OER to correct the minutes.

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M. van Bergen asks about the graphical representation of the module nomenclature. There was some confusion about what kind of graphical representation. It is decided to make a graphic showing the different nomenclatures in a module.

AP: L. Gommer: Look into making a graphical terminology figure in the OER

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Page 3: E. van der Weide asks whether it was monitored if there was more time available for exams, as decided on line 141 of the minutes. B. van Eijk answers that this was done for the Matlab Modpro course.

It is agreed to keep a close eye on this as well.

4. Announcements

L. Gommer mentions that the program directors of SET, IDE and ME have regular meetings to make sure educational affairs match.

 Gommer mentions that she wants to discuss this with the kick-in committee of Newton regardless and see what comes out.
- L. Gommer mentions that there was a problem with a lecture coinciding with prayer times for some students and that on that same time an assessment was planned. She is going to contact the teachers to let them know that the students might be late some times and is going to ask the assessment to be moved.
- L. Gommer says that as part of the accreditation committee for BIT it was interesting to see a student chapter added to the self-evaluation. L. Gommer asks the current OLC to look into writing such a student chapter for the self-evaluation report as well. G. Stoffels mentions that last year this was already done for SET.
- G. Stoffels mentions that Kristel Braakhuis is the new master coordinator of ME and SET, Adelien Heutink is the new master coordinator for IDE and SET and Eva Blokhuis is the new master coordinator for CEM and CME. They do a variety of tasks including: scheduling, admission, communications with students and being a contact person for students. Jacqueline van Emmerich is the internship coordinator for the master ME and SET.
- L. Gommer explains that she is starting a master renewal program, and that the first meeting with students was positive. On the 30th of October she will have a meeting with the teachers. She assures the OLC there is not going to be TOM in the master.

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Bart Koopmans has provided cake for the OLC since he will no longer be the chairman.

6. Educational affairs

- S. Ruiter says that after the first test of dynamics 1 there was an average of 2.7 and some complaints were voiced about how the lectures were given. Students said they could not follow the explanations. This problem was already mentioned last year and should be looked into. It is suggested by G. Stoffels that S. Ruiter contacts Bert and A. de Boer about arranging some extra summary tutorials in order to prevent a knowledge gap.
- G. Stoffels mentions that next year there will be a new teacher teaching the course (in English).
 - L. Gommer asks to be informed directly the next time large problems arise with courses.
 - L. Gommer explains that J. Schilder is doing some extra evening tutorials on dynamics.
- S. Ruiter answers that they are interesting and well attended, but that they are more of a different approach to dynamics and provide extra information, so they are not meant as repairs.
