



Project code: S0 – Containers for wildlife guards

Description of the project:

Simba Nature Protection and Education Foundation (www.ngosimba.nl) intends to supply housing containers for wildlife guards to several wildlife reservations in Iran.

Because Iran is such a large country wild life guards have to stay in a reservation day and night and cannot return to their base for several weeks in a row. Therefore they require mobile housing facilities within the reservation.

Stichting Simba Nature Protection and Education Foundation wants to supply these housing facilities in the form of housing containers, converted sea containers which possess living, cooking and resting facilities as well as sanitary services. The container will be supplied by water, electricity etc. from mobile renewable energy sources, such as air to water technology, solar technology and wind energy. The containers can be transported to other locations within the reservation by means of a truck.

Support request:

So far there have been no activities regarding the project whatsoever. This means the first thing which needs to be done is to make a concrete plan, in which all the above ideas are incorporated. The necessary size of the container, the equipment, the finances and all other details have to be made concrete and written down in a project plan. The project plan has to be clarified by drawings, 3D presentations etc.

The plan can be used both for fundraising purposes and for the realization of the project and will be the guideline for the other housing containers Simba Nature Protection and Education Foundation wants to establish in Iran. Next to that the housing containers can be used also in case of a humanitarian disaster, such as an earthquake.

Description of the project:

Simba Nature Protection and Education Foundation (www.ngosimba.nl) intends to undertake, in cooperation with other organisations, several projects to help save the Iranian Cheetah from extinction.

The projects are:

- Placing traffic signs on the side of roads to warn drivers for crossing cheetahs and other wildlife
- Building wildlife viaducts to help wildlife cross roads safely
- Improving drinking facilities for both people and wildlife in Iran
- Tracking necklaces for all remaining Iranian Cheetahs
- Organize training for dogs in which dogs are trained not to attack and kill cheetahs and other wildlife but just scare them away
- Creating usefull work for local communities to generate income for them and at the same time make clear appointments with them about how to handle and protect wildlife in their area

Support request:

So far there have been contacts with several possible cooperation partners such as the UN, the Iranian Cheetah Society, Iranian universities, Stichting Spots etc. but there have been no concrete activities regarding the projects yet. This means the first thing which needs to be done is to make, in cooperation with the other participating organisations, a concrete plan for each project. All financial and other details have to be made concrete and written down in a project plan for each project. The project plans have to be clarified, if applicable, by drawings, 3D presentations etc.

The products of the centre will be sold in the centre and on the Iranian market.

Next to that the centre can operate as a business environment (with for example a restaurant, shops, housing facilities for visitors etc.) in which demand and supply for seeds, machines and other products can meet each other and conclude business deals. The centre can also assist with for example customs formalities and other administrative work and will provide internships for both Iranian and foreign students.

The whole complex will be supplied by water, electricity etc. from renewable energy sources, such as air to water technology, solar technology and wind energy.

The centre will be equipped with all modern technology in the field of livestock farming and there are always trained experts present to explain all about livestock farming to Iranian farmers, individually or during seminars, courses etc. Within the centre farmers can be educated about every aspect of livestock farming, and see the work in practice. The dairy products of the centre will be sold in the centre and on the Iranian market.

Next to that the centre can operate as a business environment, with for example a restaurant, shops, housing facilities for visitors etc., in which demand and supply for livestock, machines and other products can meet each other and conclude business deals. The centre can also assist with for example customs formalities and other administrative work and will provide internships for both Iranian and foreign students.

The whole complex will have a typical Dutch appearance and will be supplied by water, electricity etc. from renewable energy sources, such as air to water technology, solar technology and wind energy.

Description of the project:

Simba Nature Protection and Education Foundation (www.ngosimba.nl) intends to establish several animal shelters for domestic animals such as dogs, cats, small rodents etc. in Iran.

In the shelters (homeless) domestic animals will receive, if necessary, medical treatment. The medical services of the shelters are also open for animal owners who want to have medical treatment for their animals, of course against paying the treatment costs.

Once the (homeless) animals are ready for relocation, a new owner will be chosen carefully and there will be supervision of the animal in its new home regularly.

The shelters will be established according to European standards and will be situated in a pleasant park environment, which is equipped with in- and outdoor space for the animals, playing facilities etc. Housing for a few volunteers and trainees (Iranian and foreign), a restaurant, a shop and a playing area with some playground equipment will also be part of the shelter. Other sources of income are for example training courses for (cattle) dogs and similar activities.

This way the shelter is able to generate its own income and is not depending on continuous funding by Simba Nature Protection and Education Foundation.

Funding for the establishment of the animal shelters will be acquired by general fundraising activities.

The whole complex will be supplied by water, electricity etc. from renewable energy sources, such as air to water technology, solar technology and wind energy.

Project code: S06-Animal Hospital in Yazd, central Iran

Description of the project:

Simba Nature Protection and Education Foundation (www.ngosimba.nl) intends to establish an animal hospital in Yazd, central Iran.

In the hospital many kinds of wild and domestic animals (varying in size from for example a rabbit or a cat to animals with the size of an adult horse or donkey) will receive medical treatment. The hospital will be established for animals which are injured or otherwise in need, but is also open for animal owners who want to have medical treatment for their animals, of course against paying the treatment costs.

Once the injured animals are cured, wild animals will be returned to nature and domestic animals without an owner will be placed with a new owner.

The hospital will be established according to European standards, in a zoo-like environment, which is also equipped with large animal stays, a restaurant / conference centre, one or more shops, a playing area with some playground equipment, a children farm, a small museum, an education centre etc. Next to that a barn / engine house, indoor parking space for a few ambulances, parking space for volunteers and visitors as well as housing for about 6 volunteers and trainees (Iranian and foreign) needs to be available. This way the hospital is able to generate its own income and is not depending on continuous funding by Simba Nature Protection and Education Foundation.

Funding for the establishment of the hospital will be acquired by general fundraising activities.

The whole complex will be supplied by water, electricity etc. from renewable energy sources, such as air to water technology, solar technology and wind energy.
