Context

- SoTL: the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning

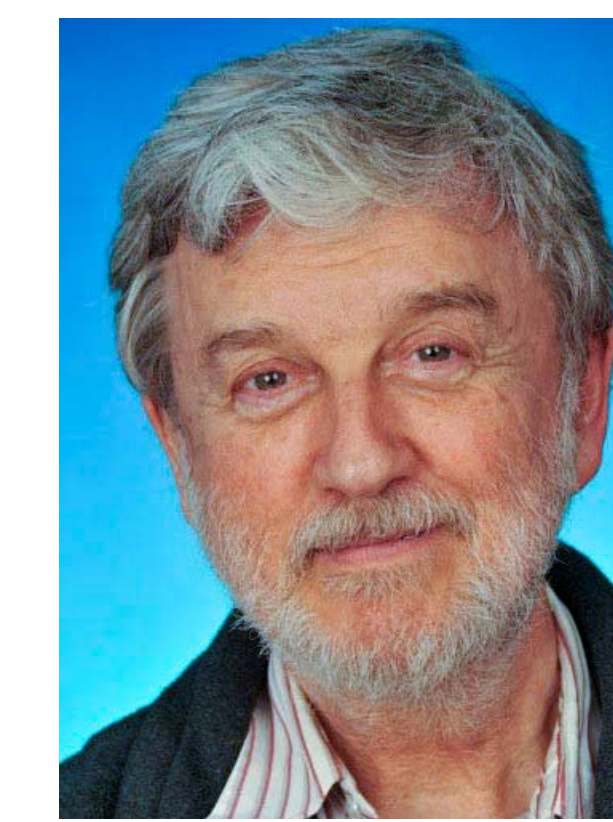

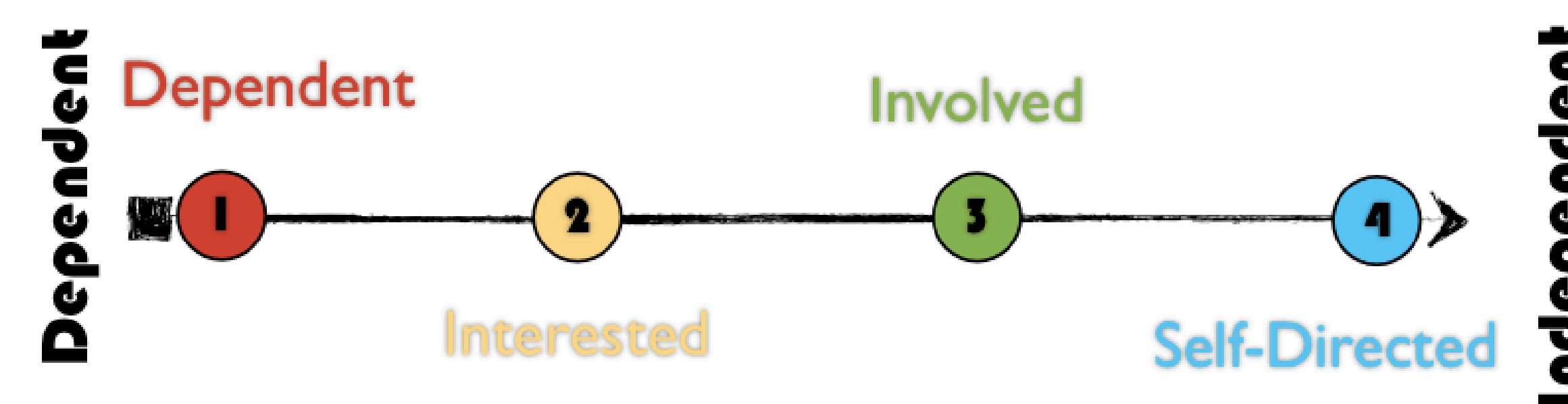
