

STEP-BY-STEP

MOMI (RESIDENCE PERMIT)

THE MODERN MIGRATION ACT (*MOMI*) IS THE DUTCH IMMIGRATION LAW. IT REQUIRES ALL NON-EEA STUDENTS WITH A RESIDENCE PERMIT FOR STUDY PURPOSES TO ACHIEVE SUFFICIENT STUDY PROGRESS (50%) EVERY ACADEMIC YEAR. IT ALSO REQUIRES THEM TO PROVIDE PERSONAL DATA AND INFORMATION ABOUT THEIR STAY TO THE UNIVERSITY OF TWENTE (UT) AND IMMIGRATION AND NATURALISATION SERVICE (*IND*).

DURING THE ACADEMIC YEAR, STUDENTS ARE INFORMED ABOUT THEIR STUDY PROGRESS SO FAR. AT THE END OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR, LACK OF STUDY PROGRESS WITHOUT A JUSTIFIABLE REASON (*STEP 4 OR 5*) WILL BE REPORTED TO THE IND AND CONTINUE STUDYING AT UT IS NOT POSSIBLE.
