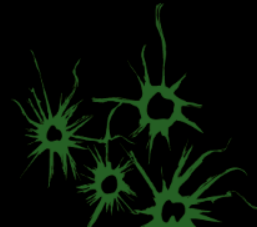


Online form B3 Electives


