Rules in the pre-master Communication Studies

1. The maximum registration period for completing the pre-master's programme is one (1) year for all students.
2. During this period (one year, 2 semesters!) a student may maximal sit two (2) times for an (interim) exam. If a student fails to pass the second time for one or more (interim) exams the student will receive a negative and binding study-advice. The student consequently will be excluded from the pre-master's programme Communication Studies.
3. Obligatory prior knowledge to start with the course **Research Project (201200066)** is: ***Communication Science, Research Methodology and Descriptive Statistics*** at least grade 5 AND ***Academic Writing pre-master*** at least grade 6
