

i. Transitional arrangements

1. Regulation 2011-2012 regarding study units of the first year

Occasion: This regulation is necessary because the first year's programme changes, starting September 2011.

Term of validity: until September 1, 2013.

Contents of the regulation:

Students who started their studies in 2010-2012 take their first year exam if they meet the following requirements:

1. They have completed units of study with a study load totalling 60 EC;
2. The list of units they have completed is (or can be) a combination of units of the 2010-2011 programme, and the 2011-2012 programme
3. According to the table below, they meet the requirements (by substitution) of the 2011-2012 programme.

The table below shows how units of study may replace one another to fulfil the requirements of the first year examination.
