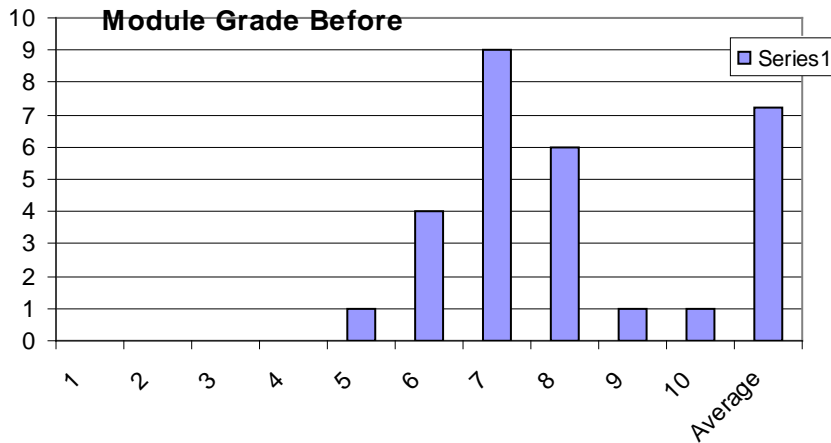
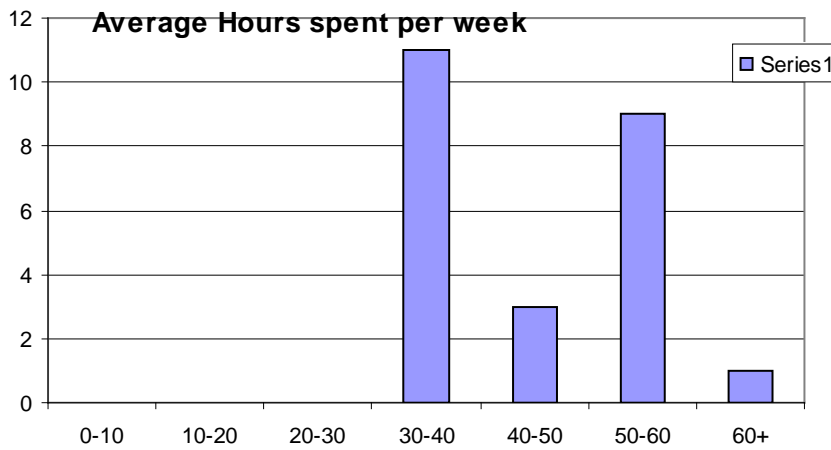

1) Module grade at start of questionnaire: 7.23 average



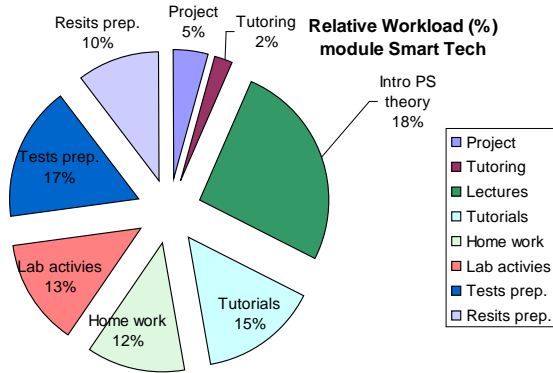
2) amount of hours spend on average in this module

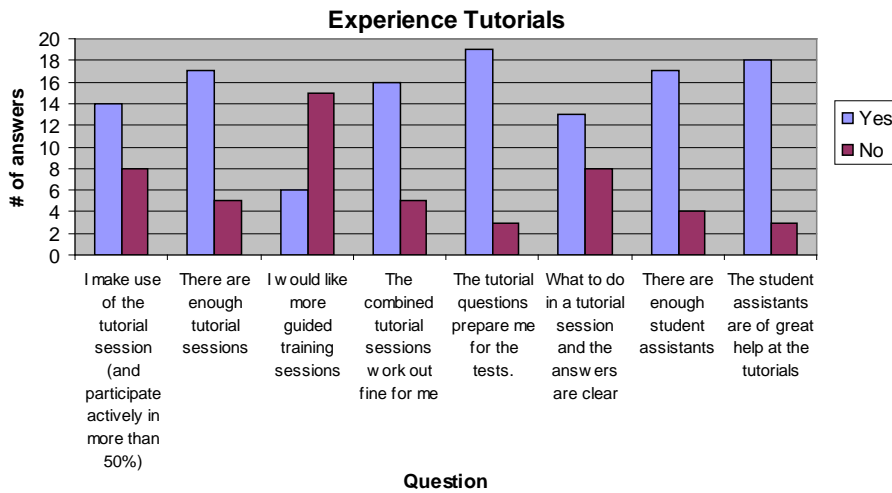

The assistance are sometimes to sparse, but most of the time sufficient.

For students it would be better to have a lecture, tutorial and a lecture again in one day. This module we had lectures on one day and tutorials on the other which just doesn't work out, because you will

lose the students their attention.

More tutorial sessions!!

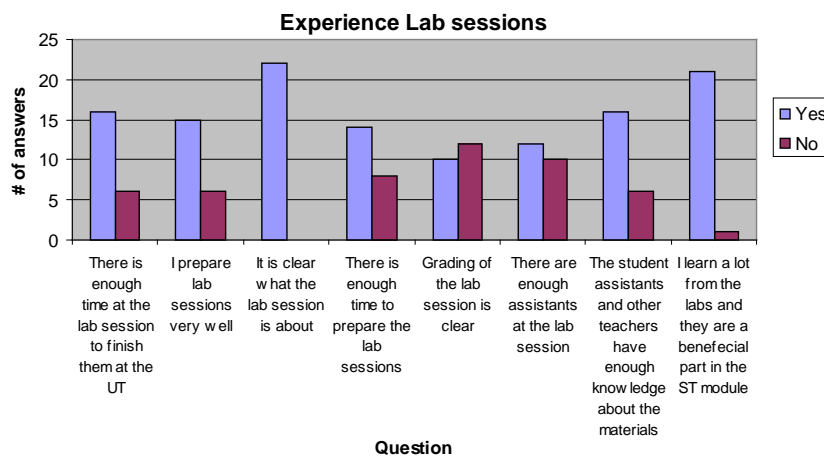
I think the combined sessions are confusing, theres too much to do for multiple subjects. I usually end up doing only 1 subject.

Make them a little bit smaller

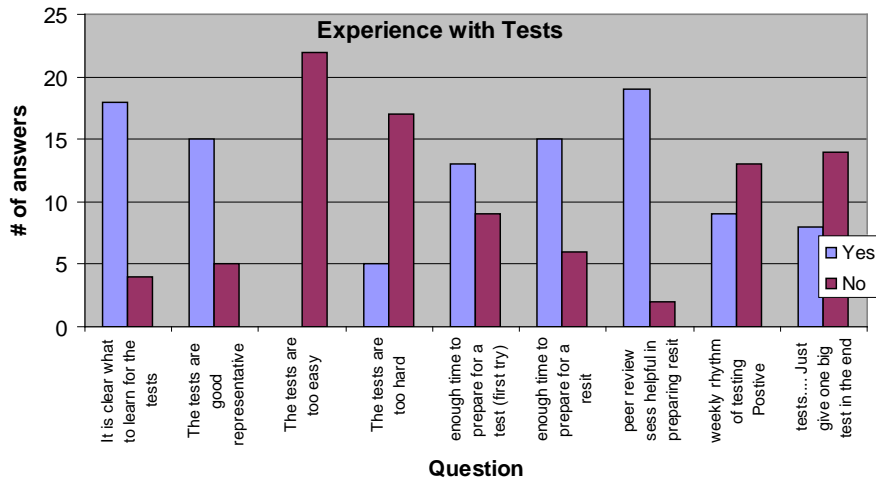
Little mistakes can get you stuck during a lab session, especially when assistants do not know whats going on.

Difficult to finish in time. If all goes well no problem but as soon as something goes wrong there is not enough time and the student assistants are always busy

6) Experience of the Tests



The peer review sessions are VERY helpful. I would like more pre-tests to see what kind of questions to expect in the real one. Practicetests please!

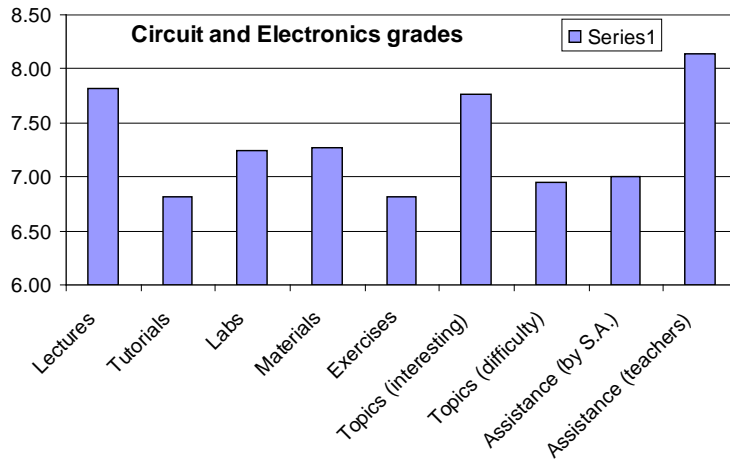
Nice to have lots of tests, but if you fail one test and need to prepare for the resits, you lose most of the time you otherwise have for studying for the next test.

7) Opinion about Circuits & Electronics

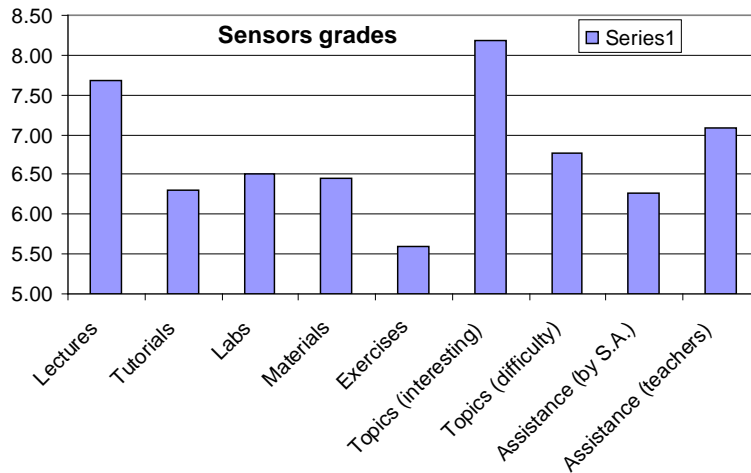


Comments:

What is the difference between lab and tutorial here?

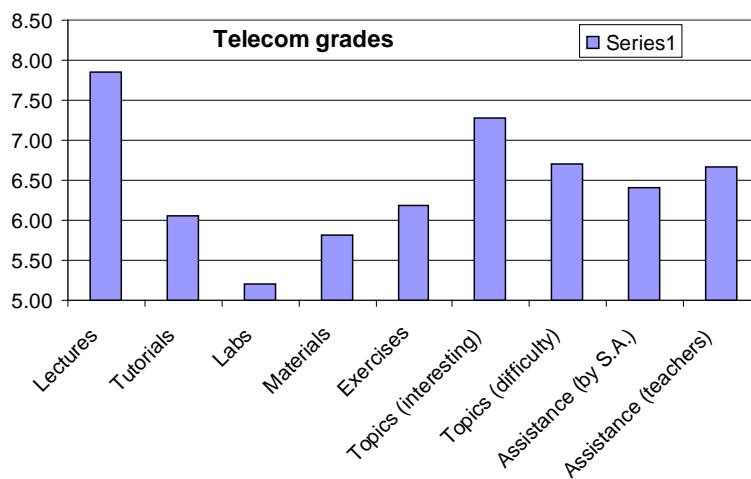
Question are really vague and there is no direct feedback or awnsers for the questions

The reader and lab sessions are hard to follow if you've been away from the Arduino for a while.

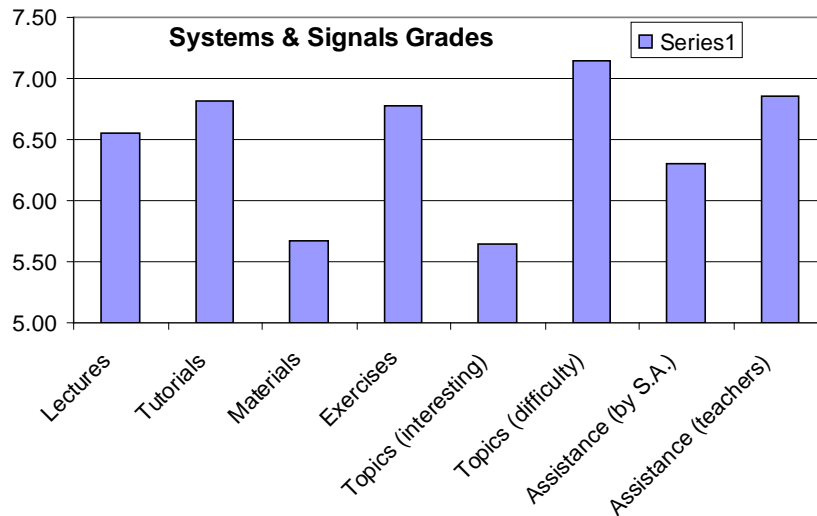
9) Opinion about Intro to Telecom

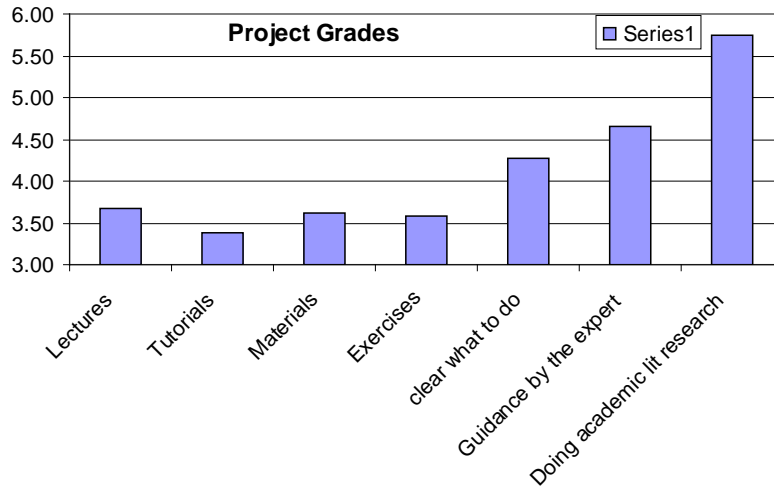
10) Opinion about Systems & Signals

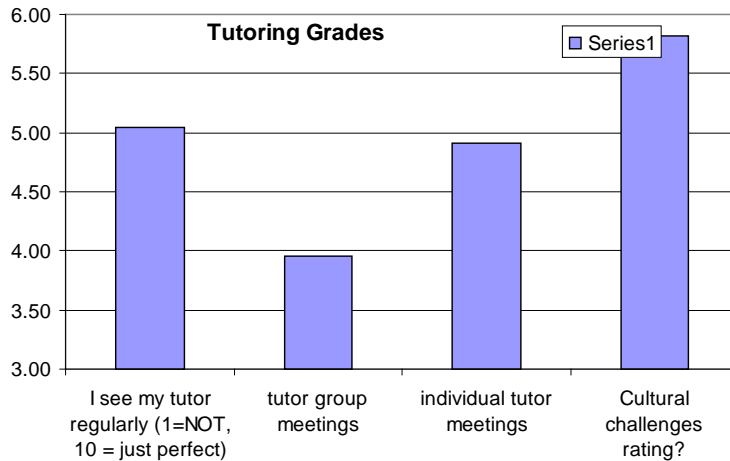
Good that this is a bit smaller individual project

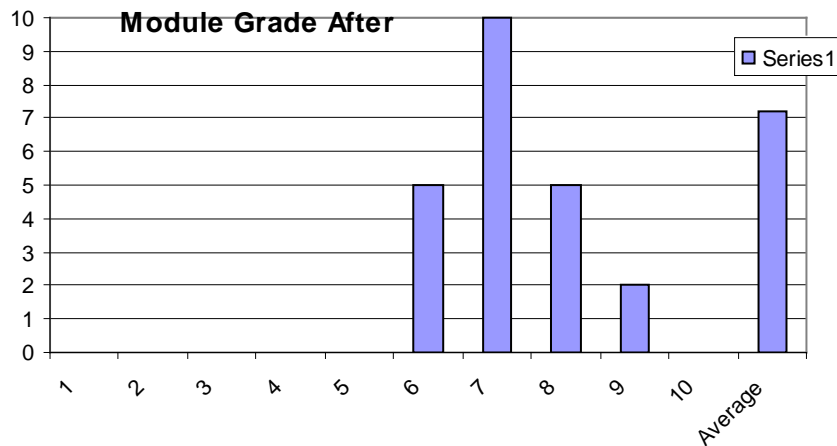
It would be nice to have the results of the sensors assignments some time before the test about the material so that there is time to assess your own knowledge.

General Remarks

The whole module has a good cohesion, everything is well related to each other and courses interact with each other's subjects.

Courses

Systems & Signals

The teacher has difficulty in choosing the right words and finding the good terms. However he wants to explain it even if you don't get.

The lectures lack examples and since there the slides are not self-explanatory and no book references are missed. Luckily during circuits & electronics the formulas are used in examples.

Sensors

Good teacher, lectures are clear and the reader is good especially the references.

The bad part of the course is making circuits with Arduino which some people haven't done since last year January (half year difference). Suggestion to give a recap lecture.

Also the student assistants are not always well prepared and need too much time in answering questions.

Circuits & Electronics

Great book, Erik is a great teacher and Cora can answer all your question perfectly.

It is difficult, but on a challenging level.

Also is this the course where all the other courses of the module come together.

You have too less time for assignments and people need more time to ask question. Suggestion is to plan an hour before the lecture to ask question, people will come if they really have questions.

Tests

The test (about C&E and S&S) was difficult but do-able if you had learned. More difference between the kind of questions, now there was too much insightful question and almost no questions you can learn by heart.

Also a formula sheet would be nice since it was not clear which formulas you should know by heart and which were given on the test.

General Remarks

The modules are still quite full but with what they teach the students find it understandable. The small exams during the course are supposed to be small tests but the students find these tests actually quite big. Also the re-exams or redo for the tests are planned quite close to the follow up test making learning for the next test very hard and very cramped. Also resulting in when you get behind you will probably stay behind. Students suggest maybe spreading the ST module over 2 quartiles?

The courses however are still properly built on each other and support each other well.

Courses

Telecommunications

The teacher is considered very good and very enthusiastic. However there is a high amount of study material and students are unsure which parts they need to get out of this. Maybe a summary of what the students actually need to get from this course?

Control systems

Teacher uses a very low amount of examples in comparison to the theory but since the course just started no full judgment can be made yet. He's very quick in his theory but not making clear what the actual goal of the course is. The potential of the course is however quite high according to the students.

Sensors

The students would like a quick refreshment of the arduino itself. On the material front the reader refers to certain pages which no longer exist because the reader is outdated.

Apart from that the students would like the student assistants to show them an at least solution. The assistant could then explain the at least situation and when interested you can dig deeper yourself with having the basic knowledge. Last the test is very theoretical for a practical course which confused the students a bit in what they had to expect for the test.

Circuits and electronics

Students are content. Having a session before the exam was very useful. However the questions in the exam were not fully representing what had been learned. Students had to think 1 step further so having a few test questions of the same level would be nice. It was also very clear which formulas you needed for the course.

Project

The intent to teach literature research is well received by the students. However the project has become a bit chaotic. Deadlines are not clear or not met, not everyone gets feedback in time. Students would also like a bit more time for working and less time for google lessons.

Opening of the meeting at 12:45

General Remarks

Moment of having the tests (mostly on Monday morning): students like this moment to have their tests, because now they have the opportunity to spend time learning during the weekend right before the test, causing a better preparation at the students. On the other hand, there are some students who try to keep their weekend free of study-related activities, resulting in a more worse preparation for the test. Especially when there is a weekend full of activities (say a three day during camp of a student/study association) it might cause troubles. **The timing of the test:** most students don't feel awake enough to make their test on 8:45 on Monday morning. They propose to have the test starting at 10:45 to get (hopefully) better results. Because there are also a lot of students (estimated on 50%) who prefer to have their tests on Friday, it is a good thing to have the first test on Monday and the resit on Friday.

Peer-reviews: unfortunately, there are some students who see the first test as a sort of 'practice exam' and go immediately for the resit as their 'real exam'. The reason for this can be the absence of practice exams before the first test. Besides that, there were some students who didn't get the rule at which a student had to go to the peer-review in order to get the permission to make the resit. However, the peer-reviews were experienced as very helpful/useful.

Workload/Study load: A few students (mostly students which have less experience with physics topics) make all of the assignments of all courses. When they fail the first test, they are making all the assignments over. This is causing a very high workload for these students. The reason for this is that these students have problems knowing which assignments are necessary to make and which are less necessary. A solution for this problem would be, letting the teacher assign priorities at the given assignments. In this way, these students know what are the most important assignments. Also, they could tell which extra assignments are helpful to make if a student has troubles with a certain topic.

Assignments: A suggestion of the students would be, having some assignments which look like the questions asked at the tests before the tests. Most of these questions go a little bit further then the regular questions which are in the book. They would like to see some of these questions a little bit earlier than only on the tests. Also a practice exam would help with this.

Courses

Systems & Signals

There is **missing a hand-out or book**. The slides, which are online at Blackboard, are understandable during the lectures, but hard to get when preparing for the tests at home. During these moments of self study there is missing a book or hand-out explaining the lecture slides. During the module Erik send a copy of one chapter out of a study book to all students. This chapter was very helpful when learning for the tests. Maybe the University can buy this chapter for the students next year?

The teacher was very helpful during the lectures/tutorials.

Circuits & Electronics

The course has a good structure. The study assistants were helpful during the tutorials. A suggestion for next year: on forehand of the practicals a small lecture, which include a lesson on “how to debug a build set-up on a breadboard?”. Also, it could be useful to get everyone using the same colors cables for the same functions within a set-up on a breadboard (black should be negative/ground, red should be positive etc.).

Sensors

Some students had a little trouble with remembering how they had to control/program an Arduino at the start of the course. A **‘catch-up’ lecture/tutorial** on this subject (given by study assistants) right before the first lecture may be a good idea for the next year.

Other students (especially the students which are convenient with programming) experienced some assignments as less challenging as they would like to get them. They expected mostly a higher level of programming. On the other hand, there were enough students who already got enough challenge with the existing assignments.

The readers within this course were really helpful: they consisted a lot of background information on the subjects, which was useful. However, it would be nice to have the **readers updated** next year (links weren't working anymore etc.).

The **feedback on their report was a bit minimal**. Comments were general (things were only reviewed as ‘good’ or ‘not good’, without explaining why). A suggestion for this problem would be, letting student assistants check the reports or having small feedback talks with the students (at which they can ask their questions about the report).

Telecommunication

The teacher had very much knowledge about the subjects around telecommunication and was very enthusiastic during the lectures. This motivated the students a lot. However, there was still some uncertainty about what the students had to learn for the test. A suggestion would be, marking in the slides which of them are important to learn and which of them are less important or would be having a **practice exam** before the test.

The sheet of paper, at which the students could write some formulas and which they could keep during the test (“spiekbriefje”), is experienced as very useful by the students.

Control Systems

The teacher Peter Breedveld knew a lot about the subjects he was explaining to the students. However, for most students **the explanation during the lectures went to quick**. This cause of this could be the use of jargon/terminology by the teacher. Fortunately, most students had no troubles with learning the subjects using the learning material after the lectures.

The explanation about matrixes was also experienced as quite difficult, while this subject was not necessary to learn for the test. This was also discussed in the previous evaluation, what resulted in an extra tutorial at which the students got more explanation about the subject. Unfortunately there weren't so much students.

Most students experienced the **bond graphs as a difficult** subject. Maybe it would be a good addition if the students would use these graphs in a practical way, somewhere in the module.

A suggestion from the students: maybe the different subjects within this course would become more clear if every subject would be **explained along the same example** (this could be a Segway or temperature controller). Then the students will get which lectures are about which part of such a system and there will be more of a line between the different lectures/subjects.

Why isn't the first lecture about "Why are control systems necessary?" and "Where do we use them for?". The students got the feeling that this was made clear somewhere halfway the module.

Some students said that the lecture about PID-controllers, given by Edwin Dertien, could take place much earlier within the module. Others said that this isn't true, because first some math has to be given to really understand this lecture.

Project

The planning and the idea of the project at first was good. However, the **shifting of the deadlines** and the **uncertainty at the experts/coaches** of the project groups, caused the most problems. Some of these experts had too little time or didn't know what they had to do.

The project included the subject "How to write a paper?". A nice addition would be, having a optional LaTeX course.

There was a lot of **uncertainty around the poster-sessions**. On forehand there was no explanation on how a poster had to be made. Also, the tutors had to examine the posters during these sessions, but the students had the feeling that these tutors gave their rates along different guidelines.

The students experienced the **lectures about Google Scholar and Google Scopus as not necessary and not interesting**. It may be a better idea to have a lecture on how to make a poster for the poster session or a lecture on how to do a good research.

Recommendations from final Evaluations Module 5a – Smart Technology

On January 21st, 2015, most Smart Tech lecturers gathered for the final evaluation of the Smart Technology module.

Most likely Edwin Dertien will be next year's module coordinator. The recommendations provided here are based on the summary of the 6 evaluations performed in this module. These are provided at the end of this document.

First impressions of all teachers about the Smart Tech module:

Joke Oosterhuis: a pity that many students didn't like the research project, although there was also a substantial group who liked it. It is better for next year to appoint a project coordinator who has knowledge about the content in the project (and who serves not only as a process coach). Advise to couple student earlier to an expert. Cora states that actually expertise is not the bottle-neck and we can also randomly assign students to teachers. All the ST teachers can handle the depth required for all possible topics within this module.

Mark: really liked to give this course for CreaTe. CreaTe students are very interactive and ask completely different questions as compared to EE students. Very pleased with the course of the module.

Cora: students worked really hard and are really motivated. Room for improvement in the combinatorial sessions.

Paolo: First time he taught at BSc level students. He liked it. The schedule is in the way it is set up now very sensitive towards illness of student or teacher. It is too critical. Three opportunities for testing the same material within the module is too much.

Geert: seeking to optimize/fit his role as coordinator of the Control Systems part. All the lecturers teaching within this part have completely different styles and topics and it is challenging to find the right balance between level, amount and pace in each part and the coherence between the parts. Apart from that it went fine.

Erik: Challenging to be module coordinator. Constant alertness is at higher level as compared to being a "mere" teacher of a topic in the module. It was very nice to work in a group of enthusiastic colleagues and to teach for a group of motivated students. For a first time it was a very good module.

Recommendations for next year:

- Alternatives for the test load for both teachers and students. The test protocol consisted of 6 tests (regular test – peer review session – resit) + a final resit. This was for students and teachers a heavy schedule. For next year:
 - Take out the final resit
 - Take out the resits within the module
 - At the end of the module reserve a whole day for resits. Students can choose to take resit there for any of the tests.

- Keep the peer review sessions. Add an extra session 1 or 2 days before the resit day.
- Do one or two diagnostic tests in week 1 and 2 to find out for the teachers and students if everybody is at the right place. If there are students who are not fitted for Smart Tech they can still move to the New Media module without a delay in study programme.
- Combined tutorial sessions: idea was good, practical implementation not. In practice they contributing courses turned out to function as two separate pieces. To be successful, next year new combined assignments should be made in which the two respective courses in the combitutorial are worked on simultaneously.
- The level of integration was appreciated by both students and teachers. The draw side is the vulnerability it poses when students or teachers are ill or who miss one or two days. The way the schedule has been set up (following the flow of the theory and not as in the “old days” a course at a fixed day in the week) is fitting to such level of integration. For next year, it is advised to use this year’s schedule as a basis and optimize it.
- The work load is very high. Some of the teachers doubted if the actual amount of content is 10.5 EC of Smart Tech materials or that it is more than this. A critical look should be taken at: Circuits and Electronics (what is necessary), Control Systems (now a scattered course with all kinds of modelling tools and mathematical techniques taught by 4 different teachers), Systems & Signals (what is necessary).
- Control Systems: the recommendation is to focus on a few modelling techniques which are applied to one or two cases to get some in depth experience. Right now, students are busy for more than half of the course to learn new techniques and mathematical tools before applying these in context (no time for embedment of the materials). It simply takes time to learn all these tools so better focus on a selected few of them and use these in all situations.
- Create more breathing space in the module:
 - Removal of all 6 resists throughout the module should reduce pressure for both students and teachers and give more space throughout the module.
 - The amount of material will be critically looked at.
 - Move the project more to the earlier phases of the module to create more space at the end of the module (where Control Systems is the heaviest topic).
- Systems and Signals: solve the returning issue of lack of study material (only slides). A book is proposed (Engineering Mathematics, by Croft et al., 4th edition, 2013). This book is most relevant for both Systems and signals and Control Systems. All teachers agree on using this book next year. It is recommended to incorporate this book also in Year 1 (modules 2 and 3) instead of the Thomas’ Calculus book.
- Lab versus theory. Teachers agreed that ratio theory versus labwork is ok. Possible new lab session that can integrate different topics: active (OpAmp) filters.
- Project:
 - The project is considered very useful by the teachers and they recommend to keep this in with the focus on literature research. The start of the project was ok (introduction + describing fascination).
 - Role of information specialist was not clear.
 - Final responsible person was not clear (module coordinator or project coordinator). Make sure the division of tasks and roles is more clear. Make sure that enough supervisors are available for all students (more are needed next year!!!).
 - Have a project coordinator who is also expert on (more confident with) content level

- Assign students earlier to a project coach. All ST teachers have sufficient fundamental knowledge to supervise all kinds of ST topics. This creates more flexibility in assigning coaches to students and it can then be done in an earlier phase of the module.
- Peer review session can work very well (for instance have students explain their research question to their peers in their group and discuss this).

Recommendations by students (randomly ordered). These are also below.

- Session on structured working with breadboards and how to debug errors in breadboard
- Refresher tutorial on Arduino and Processing prior to the start of Sensors?
- Incorporation of one big complicated project where you work on part by part throughout the module
- More space to put in creative ideas in the module?
- Have one or two build-in “breathing” moments in the module
- Make some parts of the module optional to relieve high work load
- For some of the assignments: state what the level is (minimum required, very hard level etcetera) to better estimate the level at which exam is tested
- Formula sheets at all tests (not only Telecom)?
- As an assignment: have students make their own formula sheets per topic
- For students good at programming: create extra challenging assignments for them in Sensors
- Take one example as a red threat throughout the control systems topic
- Last lecture of Control Systems (practical on PID controlling with Arduino) would have helped in the beginning to gather insight in this material.

Summary all Evaluations

Time period: Q1 of academic year 2014 – 2015 (September 1st – November 7th, 2014)

The following evaluations were used:

- The standard UT evaluation (EvaSys) at the end of the Module
- 4 CREEC (CREate Evaluation Committee) evaluations dated: 17 september (intermediate panel discussion), 7 October (intermediate panel discussion), 31 October (whole group including teachers panel discussion), 12 november (after the module panel discussion)
- Mid-term digital evaluation by the ST teaching staff via SurveyMonkey (October 2nd)

Findings of most important (returning) GENERAL items:

Positive

- This module was judged with the highest grade of all UT module 5 this quartile.
- Teachers and teaching assistants were highly rewarded (energy, enthusiasm, willingness to spend time in the students and clear in explanations)
- Study materials were rewarded as good (a.o.: C&E book, Sensors reader, reader Gjerrit, book Dynamical Systems)
- Module was challenging and instructive (leerzaam)
- Module was coherent and well integrated (which was at the same time a risk)
- Testing on Monday morning (although starting at 10.45 was preferred)
- Peer review sessions were highly rewarded
- Lab and practical sessions highly appreciated in their support of theory
- Module was to large extent in accordance with student expectations
- No deadlines for the components (as compared to modules 1-4)
-

Negative

- Time table not always optimal (too critical scheduling → 2 days of illness and important topic may be missed).
Disadvantage of high level of integration
- Study load was very high (numbers from final and mid-term questionnaires):
 - < 40 hrs/week: 46.2% and 45.8%
 - 40 – 50 hrs/week: 23.1% and 12.5%
 - > 50hrs/week: 30.8% and 41.7%
- Module doesn't fit well for all learning styles (too few different learning styles?)
- Little time to prepare for tests (pace was very high and once in resit trajectory then hard to get out)
- Weekly tests is too heavy, too many tests (6 in total)
- Too many lectures on one day (especially in the beginning of module), more variation on a day needed
- Smart XP is very noisy as a tutorial room
- Too few training (tutorial) sessions
- Combined tutorial sessions didn't work out as hoped (not enough integrated and not enough time per topic)
- Too few student assistants on lab sessions and Sensor labs (solving little problems sometimes took way too much time)
- Too little settling time in module, no breathing moments, one continuous train
- Above item becomes especially a problem if one test was missed/failed
- Not always clear what to learn for a test
- Test 1 was directly after the Gogbot weekend → try to avoid this next year
- In some of the tests many questions went beyond the level practiced during lessons (true for test 1)
- Context of some of the lectures within the course or module was not always clear

Findings of most important items per TOPIC:

Positive:

- Systems & Signals was explained very well
- Sensors was a very practical and insightful course
- Telecom teacher very enthusiastic and motivating
- Integrating character of Circuits and Electronics (applies the math learned and is foundation for other courses)
- Control Systems was a challenging and high potential part

Negative:

- Sensors: reader was very good but outdated
- Sensors: not always clear how assignments were graded and tutorial questions were regarded as vague
- Sensors: too few student assistance for physically sign off assignments
- Book needed for Systems and Signals! Learning math from slides is not very doable
- Sensors test was unexpectedly theoretical as compared to materials worked on
- Telecom contains a lot of material; not always clear what is important or not
- Sensors: SA not always knowing what to do in case deviation from the right track (especially programming related items)
- Laplace part of math: not well integrated or needed for other parts?
- Control Systems: why matrices?
- Bond graphs in Control Systems were hard to grasp and were not practiced / placed in the bigger picture
- Prior knowledge expected in Control Systems that students didn't have (e.g. partial derivatives)
- Control Systems was experienced as bits and pieces; too many new subjects / theory
- Reader of Gjerrit for Control was very helpful but unfortunately group of students didn't know of its existence
