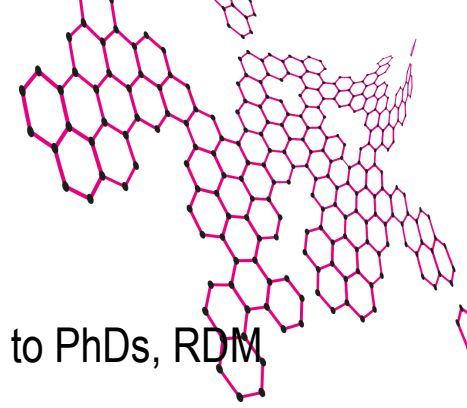

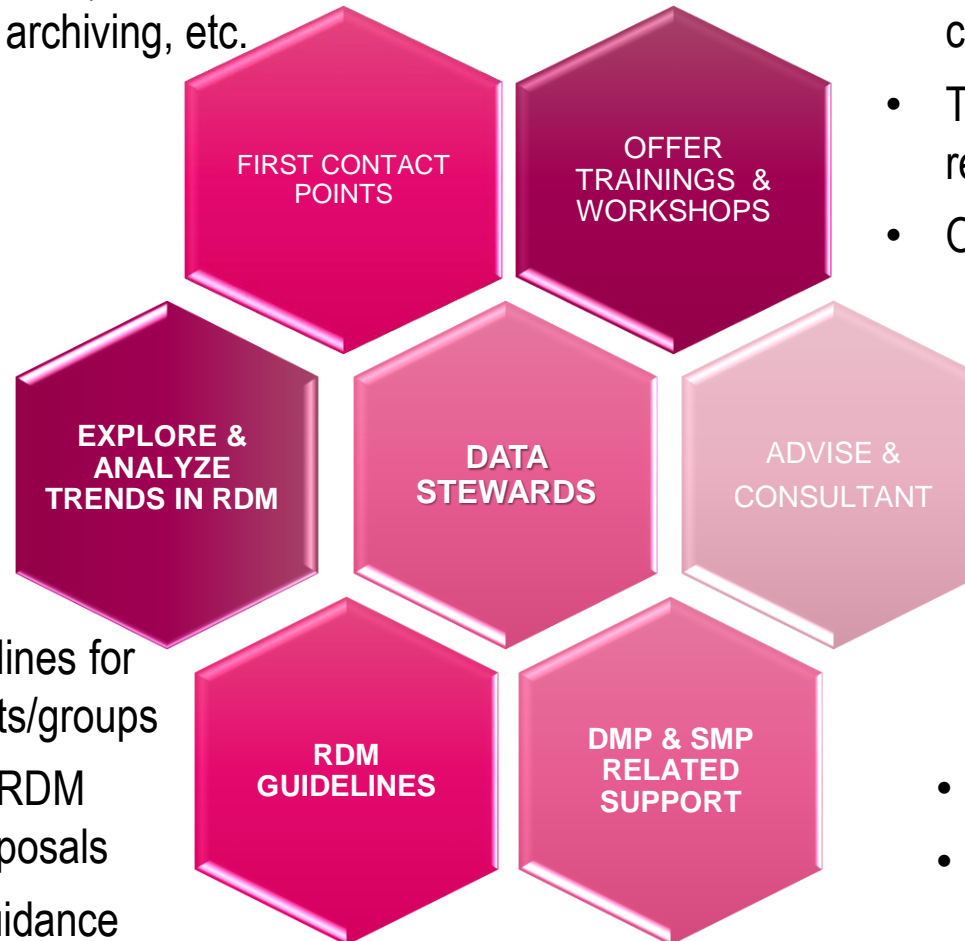

# What do data stewards do @ UT?



- First contacts for any research data management (RDM) matters (data storage, documentation, archiving, etc.)
- Active participation in (national & international) communities to keep up with the most recent developments in RDM
- Team up with others on topics that are in common interests



- Develop RDM guidelines for research departments/groups
- Develop guides for RDM section for grant proposals
- Develop thematic guidance (e.g. anonymization guide)

- Provide RDM bootcamp to PhDs, RDM classes for students
- Thematic trainings (e.g. demo on using a repository)
- Organize software carpentries
- Offer consultancy and assistance on proper data management (e.g. data storage during research, handling personal data & archiving after research)
- Review DMPs & SMPs from PhDs
- Review the data management paragraph/section in grant proposals and DMP for granted projects

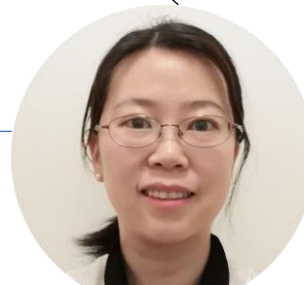

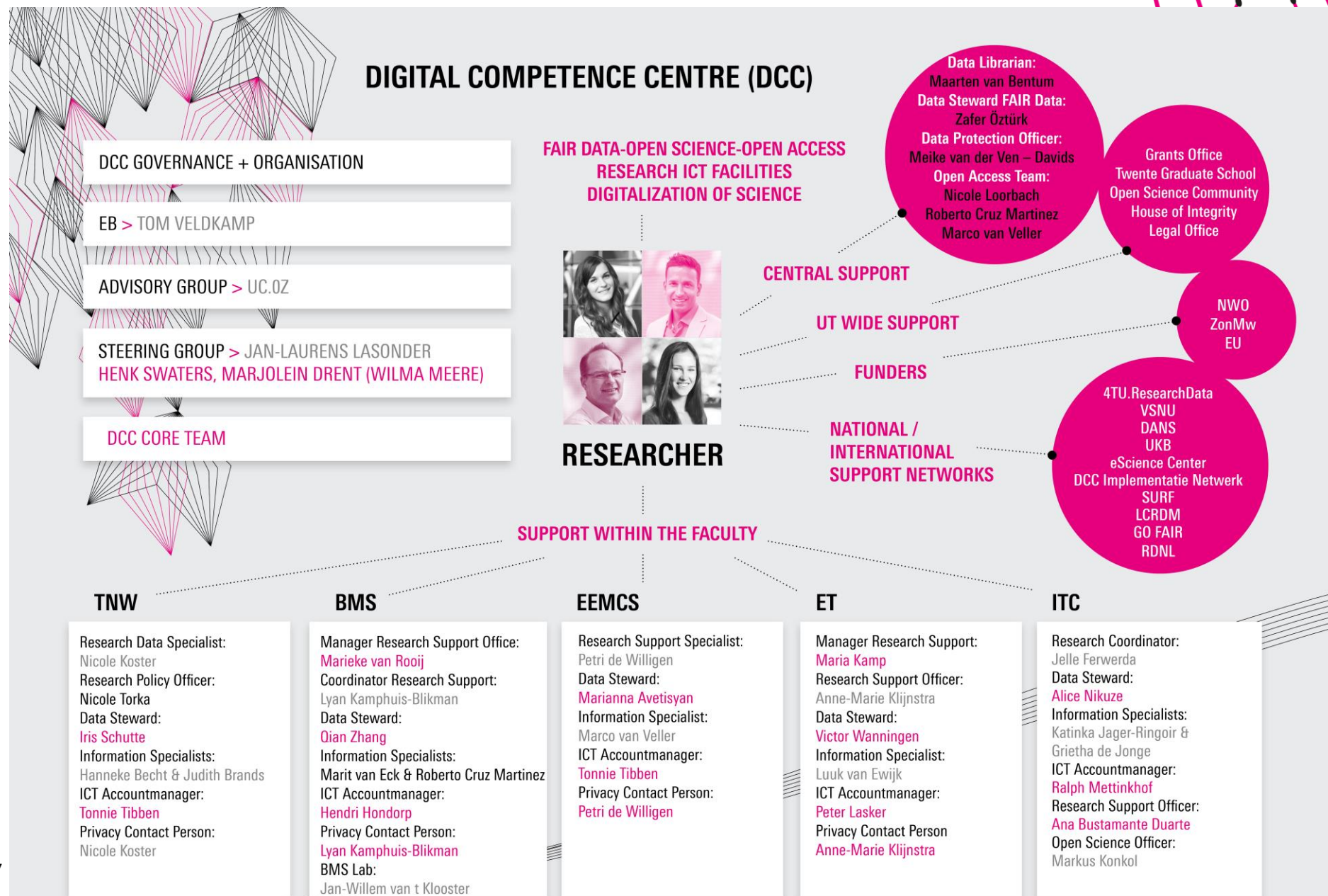
