

## **DECISIONS Executive Board 11-07-2022**

- 1. Minutes EB-meeting d.d. 04-07-2022** (agenda-item 2)  
The Executive Board decides to approve the minutes of the EB-meeting d.d. 04-07-2022.
- 2. Action Plan Diversity, Equity & Inclusion 2022-2024** (agenda-item 3)  
The Executive Board decides to approve the Action Plan Diversity, Equity and Inclusion 2022-2024.
- 3. Mandated decisions** (agenda-item 4)  
b. In accordance with the proposal of the Dean of EEMCS, the Executive Board decides to appoint Mr C. Brune as a Professor in the chair of Nonlinear Analysis as of 1 July 2022 within the framework of the Tenure Track.
- 4. Connecting Industries Call 13** (agenda-item 5)  
The Executive Board decides to adopt the recommendation of the SBD internal advisory board to approve three out of the four proposals submitted for Connecting Industry Call 13 for submission to TKI HTSM. The combined budget of the three selected proposals amounts to 4.905.000,- Euros of which 1.850.500,- Euros will be requested from TKI HTSM and an equal amount will be contributed in cash by the private partners.  
  
The three proposals given a positive advice by the SBD internal advisory board are the following:
  - MechLifePerfect - Matthijn de Rooij (ET)
  - ChipTechTwente ACDACT - Bram Nauta (EEMCS, DSI, MESA+)
  - The stented vascular twin - Bob Geelkerken (S&T, TechMed).
- 5. Regulation lowering tuition fee for students from conflict areas** (agenda-item 6)  
The Executive Board decides to approve the addendum to the Enrolment Regulations 2022-2023 that details the lowering of tuition fees for refugees and asylum-seeking students. To send the addendum for information to the University Council. To evaluate the addendum after 1 year and, if fit for purpose, include it in the regular policies and procedures of the Enrolment Regulations.
- 6. Application Fee: From pilot to regular business** (agenda-item 7)  
The Executive Board intends to decide to make the application fee part of the UT regular business by removing the label 'pilot' and making the necessary arrangements in the internal administration systems. In contrast to the pilot phase, this will mean the application fee will not be refunded upon enrollment. Faculties can decide if and for which of their Master's programmes it would be suitable to ask for this fee.
- 7. Annual Report UTH 2021** (agenda-item 8)  
The Executive Board decides at the general meeting of shareholders University of Twente Holding:
  - to adopt the 2021 financial statements
  - to discharge the executive board of UTH of liability in respect of the policy pursued in 2021
  - to withdraw the result from the general reserve.
- 8. Managementreport UTH up to and incl. May 2022** (agenda-item 9)  
The Executive Board decides to take note of Universiteit Twente Holding (UTH) managementreport Up to and incl. May 2022.
- 10. Accessibility and upgrade Waaier 4** (agenda-item 12)  
The Executive Board decides to release a budget of €940.900,- incl. VAT from the LTSH budget for making the stage of auditorium Waaier 4 accessible to wheelchair users and for the refurbishment of Waaier 4.
