
ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY EXCEPTION STATEMENT



In line with the Dutch Code of Conduct International Student Higher Education, exchange students only need to proof their English proficiency once. This means that if you have met the English language requirements before your enrollment in a full English taught programme at your current university, you do not need to provide test results.
